

1. General Remarks

This is the 3rd Annual Statistical Report published by the Department of Tourism of Nepal. Statistical information on tourism in Nepal has been collected regularly since as early as 1962, providing the data for the only four publications of the Department of Tourism during this period: STATISTICS ON TOURISM IN NEPAL 1962—1970, NEPAL TOURIST STATISTICS 1962—1973, ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT 1974 & 1975.

The purpose of the Annual Statistical Reports on tourism in Nepal is to provide a continuous review, in terms of data series of the country's tourism industry and its developments to researchers, planners and policy makers as well as to all relevant public and private segments of the travel trade at home and abroad.

The data compiled in this issue covers nationality, residence, seasonality of arrivals, mode of transport, purpose of visit, length of stay, age and sex. Total foreign exchange earning from tourism and major hotel industry datas are also given in this report. Thus, this edition of the Annual Statistical Report brings information on Tourism in Nepal in line with the needs of the industry and it emphasizes the growing importance which tourism has been able to demonstrate in the national economic context and in the South Asian Region.

Since, 1974, a number of methodical and technical changes in the system of collecting data on tourism was introduced. Processing and compilation of the basic data is done through computer for more precise result so as to enlarge the overall quantity as well as refine the analytical quality of the data so far available. The Department of Tourism will continue its efforts for further improvement. So, we will welcome any sound comments from all readers of this report.

2. Sources of Data

The statistics of this report are based on information gained from the following sources:

(1) **Frontier arrival data** are compiled from disembarkation cards, departure data from embarkation cards. The cards are collected from all travellers upon entry into and exit out of Nepal. Previously this was done at Kathmandu Airport and at Birgunj border check post only. Since January 1974, the card collecting system has been extended to the land border posts of Bhairahawa and Kakarbhita (Jhapa).

The Department of Tourism receives the disembarkation and embarkation cards after registration through the immigration authorities.

(2) **Hotel industry data** are compiled from monthly reports from all major hotel establishments in Nepal. All major hotels have to submit two forms covering guest arrival movements as well as guest night statements.

(3) **Gross foreign exchange earnings** from tourism are collected and compiled by Nepal Rastra Bank. The data given in this report is based on the information received from Nepal Rastra Bank, Foreign Exchange Department.

3. Definition of Terms

The definitions used in this report correspond essentially with those recommended by the United Nations' Guidelines for Tourism Statistics (New York 1971).

According to these recommendations, the more general term "visitor" is divided into two special categories: excursionists and tourists. Excursionists are visitors not staying overnight or less than 24 hours, whereas those visitors spending more than 24 hours or at least one overnight in the country visited are called tourists.

Since Nepal does not count less-than-24-hours visitors among its incoming travellers, the number of excursionists is zero and, by definition, its number of visitors is equal to the number of tourists registered.

Length of stay is calculated on the basis of visitor's days as stated upon arrival on the disembarkation cards (intended length of stay) and on the embarkation cards before departure (actual length of stay). Computerized processing allows of the first time to comprehensively work out detailed information on this particularly interesting feature of the tourist's movements.

A Guest Night is an overnight for which payment is made in any accommodation establishment covered by the monthly hotel survey reporting system introduced since June 1974 by the Department of Tourism.

Gross foreign exchange earnings from tourism are shown on the basis of the information given by Nepal Rastra Bank, Foreign Exchange Department as "tourists" expenditure in convertible currency.

4. Processing of Data

Processing of all information based on disembarkation and embarkation cards is carried out jointly by the Department of Tourism (numerical coding) and the Electronic Data Processing Centre of the Central Bureau of Statistics (punching and processing on system IBM 1401). Hotel industry data are compiled exclusively through the Department of Tourism.

5.1 General Trend.

Total volume of international arrivals increased again in 1976 from 74599 to 85769 (excluding arrivals from India) which is equivalent to a rise of 15 percent over 1975 as against 2.7 percent in 1975. Of the total tourists arrivals 105108 (including Indians), Europe continued to be the top and accounted for 49568 tourists (47.2 percent) followed by Asia 29222 tourists (27.8 percent) North America 16752 tourists (16 percent) Australia, New Zealand and Pacific 8089 tourists (7.7 percent) and other areas 1477 (1.3 percent).

5.2 India's Market Share

Total number of Indian tourist increased again in 1976 from 17881 to 19339 (arrivals by air) which is equivalent to a rise of 8.2 percent over 1975. For the whole twelve months period, Indian tourists accounted for 18.4 percent of the total tourist arrivals. Thus Indian tourist's share to the total arrival figure constitute the highest percentage of incoming tourists traffic in Nepal.

5.3 Other markets

North American tourists arrivals increased in 1976 by 7.8 percent over 1975. Similarly European tourists increased in 1976 by 16.4 percent, Asians tourists by 9.8 percent and tourists arrivals from Australia, Newzealand & pacific increased by 23 percent over 1975. Out of the total tourist arrivals by nationalities in 1976 (excluding Indians) USA Continued to be the top generating markets with 14394 tourists (16.8 percent) as in 1975 followed by France with 11900 tourists (13.9 percent). Tourist arrivals by other major nationalities were west Germany 9157 (10.7 percent), U.K. 9210 (10.7 percent), Japan 6732 (7.8 percent), Australia 6588 (7.7 percent) and Italy 4045 (4.8 percent).

5.4 Country of Residence

Data on the countries of residence of arrivals for 1976, reveals that a considerable number of European and North American nationals visiting Nepal, live not in their home countries, but in areas of Asia and the Pacific, mainly in South Asian, South East Asia, East Asia, Australia and New Zealand (see table 16).

5.5 Modes of Transport

In general, visitors entering Nepal by land account for about 16 percent in averages, since 1967. The share of land travellers in 1976 was 13.9 percent as against 14.5 percent in the previous year 1975 (excluding Indian arrivals).

There are a few nationalities with a percentage of land visitors considerably higher than the average of 17 percent. These are New Zealanders of which 35 percent entered Nepal by land, the United Kingdom (28%), Canada (27%), Australia (27%), Switzerland (25%), and France (17%), West Germany, Denmark, Netherland and Sweden 20% each.

Among the air arrivals, RNAC dropped its share from 39.0% in 1975 to 34.3% in 1976. At the same time, Indian Airline's part in air arrivals increased from 40.9% to 48.5%. Likewise, Thai International went down to 13.5% from 14.0%.

All five scheduled carriers account for more than 99 percent of all air arrivals the remainder going to special or charter flights.

5.6 Purpose of visit

The predominant motivation for travel to Nepal is pleasure (pleasure seeking, sight seeing holiday making). Out of the total tourist arrivals in 1976 pleasure purpose accounted for 78.6 percent followed by Trekking and Mountaineering purpose 11.1 percent.

However Nepal is gaining popularity as a trekker's Shangrila, because of its mountains and scenic beauties. The data on this report shows that the share of Trekking and Mountaineering purpose has increased in last three years accounting to 12.6 percent in average as against 2.3 percent in 1973. Trekking figure does not include short treks around Kathmandu and Pokhara Valley.

The number of trekking permits issued by the Central Immigration Office has also been shown separately in this report for the first time.

The card used before 1974 gave the visitor the freedom to fill up a blank line with whatever purpose of visit. The card introduced in January 1974 requires the visitor to mark his purpose of visit out of a given set of five choices one of which is "Trekking Mountaineering".

5.7 Ports of Entry and Exit

Main point for entering and leaving by land is Birgunj. Next comes Bhairawa south of Pokhara which is gaining importance since the completion of the road link between Pokhara and the Indian border. It is interesting to note that more land travellers leave the country than enter it through Bhairawa.

Most air visitors originate from Delhi with Bangkok being a surprising second ahead of varanasi (Benares), Calcutta and Patna. Departing air arrivals are going to Delhi, first of all. Bangkok is second in the list of next destinations in front of Patna, Varanasi & Calcutta.

5.8 Duration of Stay

Average intended length of stay for the twelve months period from January to December 1976 is 11.6 days per visitor arrived in Nepal.

Average actual length of stay for the twelve months period from January to December 1976 is 12.4 days per visitor departed from Nepal.

It may be presumed that visitors, or at least part of them, hesitate to state the full length of the period intended to stay in the country, on the disembarkation card filled upon arrival. Other visitors may stay longer than originally intended. Both events may explain to a large extent the fact that actual length of stay is greater than intended length of stay.

5.9 Foreign Exchange Revenue

Gross foreign exchange earnings from tourism (as released by Nepal Rastra Bank) increased in fiscal year 1975/76 by 56 percent U.S. \$ 15,118,000 as against (US \$ 11,490,000) in 1974/75.

Thus, tourism tops the list of all foreign exchange earning items on which data are available. Left behind are transfer items such as Gorkha remittances, commodities like the combined group of raw jute and jute products.





 1966/67 - 1975/76





(EXCLUDING INDIANS)









