

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## INTRODUCTION

### 1. General Remarks

This is the 7th Annual Statistical Report published by the Department of Tourism of Nepal. Statistical information on tourism in Nepal has been collected regularly since as early as 1962, providing the data for the only four publications of the Department of Tourism during this period : STATISTICS ON TOURISM IN NEPAL 1962—1970, NEPAL TOURIST STATISTICS 1962—1973, ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT 1974, 1975, 1976, 1977, 1978 & 1979.

The purpose of the Annual Statistical Reports on tourism in Nepal is to provide a continuous information, in terms of data series of the country's tourism industry and its development to researchers, planners and policy makers as well as to all relevant public and private segments of the travel trade at home and abroad.

The data compiled in this issue covers international visitors arrivals in terms of nationality, residence, seasonality of arrivals, mode of transport, purpose of visit, length of stay, age and sex. Total foreign exchange earnings from tourism and major hotel industry datas are also given in this report. Thus, this edition of the Annual Statistical Report brings information of Tourism in Nepal in line with the needs of the industry and it emphasizes the growing importance which tourism has been able to demonstrate in the national economic context and in the South Asia Region.

Since 1974, a number of methodical and technical changes in the system of collecting data on tourism was introduced. Processing and compilation of the basic data are done through computer for more precise result so as to enlarge the overall quantity as well as refine the analytical quality of the data so far available. The Department of Tourism will continue its efforts for further improvement. So, we welcome any sound comments from all readers of this report.

### 2. Sources of Data

The statistics of this report are based on information gained from the following sources:

(1) **Frontier arrival data** are compiled from disembarkation cards, departure data from embarkation cards. The cards are collected from all travellers upon entry into and exit out of Nepal. Previously this was done at Kathmandu Airport and at Birgunj border check post only. Since January 1974, the card collecting system has been extended to the land border posts of Bhairahawa and Kakarbhita (Jhapa).

The Department of Tourism receives the disembarkation and embarkation cards after registration through the immigration authorities.

(2) **Hotal industry data** are compiled from monthly reports from all major hotel establishments

in Nepal. All major hotels have to submit two forms covering guest arrival movements as well as guest night statements.

- (3) Gross foreign exchange earnings from Tourism are collected and compiled by Nepal Rastra Bank. The data given in this report is based on the information received from Nepal Rastra Bank, Foreign Exchange Department.

### 3. Definition of Terms

The definitions used in this report correspond essentially with those recommended by the United Nation's Guidelines for Tourism Statistics (New York, 1971).

According to these recommendations, the more general term "visitor" is divided into two special categories: excursionists and tourists. Excursionists are visitors not staying overnight or less than 24 hours, whereas those visitors spending more than 24 hours or least one overnight in the country visited are called tourists.

Since Nepal does not count less-than-24-hours visitors among its incoming travellers the number of excursionists is zero and, by definition, its number of visitors is equal to the number of tourists registered.

Length of stay is calculated on the basis of visitor's days as stated upon arrival on the disembarkation cards (intended length of stay) and on the embarkation cards before departure (actual length of stay). Computerized processing allows of the first time to comprehensively work out detailed information on this particularly interesting feature of the tourist's movements.

A Guest Night is an overnight for which payment is made in any accommodation establishment covered by the monthly hotel survey reporting system introduced since June 1974 by the Department of Tourism.

Gross foreign exchange earnings from tourism are shown on the basis of the information given by Nepal Rastra Bank, Foreign Exchange Department as "tourists" expenditure in convertible currency.

### 4. Processing of Data

Processing of all information based on disembarkation and embarkation cards is carried out jointly by the Department of Tourism (numerical coding) and the National Computer Centre (punching and processing on system IBM 1401). Hotel industry data are compiled exclusively through the Department of Tourism.

### 5. Highlights

#### 5.1 General Trend

Between 1975 and 1978, visitor arrivals to Nepal increased from .09 million to 1.6 million with an average growth rate of above 15%, But this growth even slowed to 0.4% in 1980 as compared to the growth rate of previous year by 3.9%. However the data shows that the number of visitor arrivals excluding Indian tourist arrivals is decreased by 2.0% i. e. from 124753 in 1979 to 122205 over 1980. Of the total visitor arrivals 162897, western Europe continues to be a major market for travel to Nepal. It still generates around one-half of the total visitor arrivals which

accounted for 71959 visitors (44.1%) followed by Asia 61916 arrivals (38.0.) North America 17817 arrivals (11.0%) Australia, Newzealand and pacific 8081 arrivals (5.0%) and other areas 3124 arrivals (1.9%)

## 5.2 India's Market share

In 1980, 25.0% of all visitor arrivals came from India and this number increased again from 37523 to 40692 to a rise of 8.4% over 1979. This figure comprises only to arrivals by air and constitutes the highest percentage of incoming tourist traffic in Nepal. However, India still predominates the market share by 25% of the total visitor arrivals.

## 5.3 Other Markets

North American visitor arrivals decreased in 1980 by 18.7% over 1979. On the contrary, European tourists increased by 3.6% Asian tourists (including Indian) by 4.5% and Australia, Newzealand and pacific area decreased by 13.7 in the same year. By nationalities, France occupies top generating market with 18093 visitors (14.8%) followed by U. S. A. 15081 (12.2%) west Germany 13699 (11.2%) Japan 11684 (9.6%) U.K 10359 (8.5%) and Australia 6198 (5.1%).

The number of visitor arrivals from United states was increasing rapidly for the past few years. But it declined by 18.7% this year also affecting to a set back in the traditional growth rate. However, there is a continuous gain to a growth-rate of all visitor arrivals from France., U. K., Japan, Spain and Canada since 1976.

## 5.4 Country of Residence

Data on the countries of residence of arrivals for 1980 reveals that a considerable number of European and North American nationals visiting Nepal, live not in their home countries, but in areas of Asia and pacific, mainly in south Asia, South East Asia, Australia and New Zealand (see Table 13).

## 5.5 Modes of Transport

85.6% of the total visitor arrivals came by air and 14.4% by land route as against 15% in the previous year 1979. Visitors entering Nepal by land still continues to account for about 15 percent in average since 1968.

Among the air arrivals, IAC dropped its share from 34.8% in 1979 to 32.2% in 1980 At the same time, RNAC decreased its share from 50.4% to 42.2%. Likewise, Thai International went down to 7.7% from 10.6%.

THOUGH all scheduled carriers account for more than 99 percent of all air arrivals, a sizeable number of visitors would come by chartered flights.

## 5.6 Purpose of Visit

The predominant motivation for travel to Nepal is pleasure (pleasure seeking, sightseeing, holiday making). Out of the total visitors arrivals in 1980, pleasure purpose accounted for 80.4 percent followed by trekking and Mountaineering purpose 11.8 percent.

Nepal is gaining popularity as a trekker's Shangrila, because of its mountain and scenic beauties. The data on this report shows that the share of Trekking and Mountaineering purpose has constantly increased in last three years accounting to 12 percent in average as against 2.3 percent in 1979. Trekking figure does not include short treks around Kathmandu and Pokhara Valley. However, the number of trekkers who got permission for trekking increased by 38.2 percent over 1979. The number of trekking permits issued by the Central Immigration Office has also been shown separately in this report on the basis of trekking routes.

The card used before 1974 gave the visitors the freedom to fill up a blank line w/ whatever purpose of visit. The card introduced in January 1974 requires the visitors to mark purpose of visit out of a given set five choice one of which is "Trekking and Mountaineering".

### 5.7 Ports of Entry and Exit

Main point for entering Nepal by land is Birgunj. Now it has switched over to Bhairahwa south of Pokhara for entry which is gaining importance. Bhairahwa continues to predominate the port of exit by land route since 1977. It is interesting to note that more land travellers leave the country by air.

Most air visitors originate from Delhi followed by Bangkok as second ahead Varanasi (Benares), Calcutta and Patna. Departing Delhi is the first key port of call before deciding the next destination for the departing tourists.

### 5.8 Duration of Stay

Average intended length of stay for the twelve months period from January to December 1980 is 11.9 days per visitor arrived in Nepal.

Average actual length of stay for the twelve months period from January to December 1980 is 11.2 days per visitor departed from Nepal.

It may be presumed that visitors, or at least part of them, hesitate to state the intended length of the period intended to stay in the country, on the disembarkation card filled up on arrival. Some visitors may not stay originally intended. Both events may explain to a large extent the fact that actual night of stay is not greater than intended length of stay.

### 5.9 Foreign Exchange Revenue

Gross foreign exchange earnings from tourism (as released by Nepal Rastra Bank) increased in fiscal year 1979/80 by 24.57 percent U. S. \$ 44,716,000 as against US \$ 35,007,000 in 1978/79.

Thus, tourism falls second position in the source of all foreign exchange earning items on which data are available. Left behind are transfer items such as Gorkha remittance and commodities like the combined group of raw jute and jute products etc.

## 1962 / 1980





1975 / 1980






1977 / 1980








1962 / 1980


