INTRODUCTION

1. General Remarks

This is the 11th Annual Statistical Report Published by the Department of Tourism of Nepal. Statistical information on tourism in Nepal has been collected regularly since 1962.

The purpose of the Annual Statistical Report on Tourism in Nepal is to provide continuous information, in terms of data series on the country's tourism industry and its development, to researchers, planners and policy makers as well as to all relevant public and private segments of the travel trade at home and abroad.

The data compiled in this issue covers international visitor arrivals in terms of nationality, residence, seasonality of arrivals, mode of transport, purpose of visit, length of stay, age and sex. Total foreign exchange earning from tourism and major hotel industry data are also given in the report. Thus, this edition of the Annual Statistical Report brings information on Tourism in Nepal in line with the needs of the industry and it emphasizes the growing importance which tourism has acquired in the national economy and in the South Asia Region.

Since 1974, a number of methodological and technical changes in the system of collecting data on tourism have been introduced. Processing and compilation of the basic data are done by computer. This allows more precise data, increased overall quantity of data and improved analytical quality. The Department of Tourism will continue its efforts for further improvement. So, we welcome any comments from readers of this report.

2. Sources of data

The statistics of this report are based on information gained from the following sources :

(1) Frontier Arrival data are compiled from disembarkation cards, departure data from embarkation cards. The cards are collected from all travellers upon entry into and exit out of Nepal. Previously this was done at Kathmandu Airport and at Birgunj Border check post only. Since January 1974, the cards collecting system has been extended to the land border posts Bhairahawa and Kakarbhita (Jhapa).

The Department of Tourism receives the disembarkation and embarkation cards after registration through the immigration authorities.

(2) Hotel industry data are compiled from monthly report from all tourist standard hotel establishments in Nepal. All tourist standard hotels guest night statements.

(3) Gross foreign Exchange earnings from Tourism are collected and compiled by Nepal Rastra Bank. The data given in this report is based on the information received from Nepal Rastra Bank, Foreign Exchange Department.

3. The Definition of Terms

The definitions used in the report correspond essentially with those recommended by the United Nation's Guidelines for Tourism Statistics (New York, 1971).

According to these recommendations, the more general term "visitor" is divided into two special categories : excursionists and tourists. Excursionists are visitors not staying overnight or staying less than 24 hours, whereas visitors spending more than 24 hours or at least one night in the country visited are called tourists.

Since Nepal does not have visitors staying less than 24 hours among its incoming travellers the number of excursionists is zero and, by definition, its number of visitors is equal to the number of tourists registered.

Length of stay is calculated on the basis of visitor's days as stated upon arrival on the disembarkation cards (intended length of stay) and on the embarkation cards before departure (actual length of stay) Computerized processing has made it possible for the first time comprehensively to work out detailed information on this particularly interesting feature of the tourist's movements.

A Guest Night is an overnight for which payments is made in any accommodation establishment covered by the monthly hotel survey report - system introduced since June 1974 by the Department of Tourism.

Gross Foreign Exchange earnings from tourism are shown on the basis of the information given by Nepal Rastrya Bank, Foreign Exchange Department as "tourists" expenditure in convertible currency.

4. Processing of Data

Processing of all information based on disembarkation and embarkation cards is carried out jointly by the Department of Tourism (numerical coding) and the National Computer Centre (punching and processing on system IBM 1401). Data on Hotel industry and Nepali national going abroad are compiled exclusively by the Department of Tourism.

5. Highlights

5.1 General Trend

Between 1975 and 1978 visitor arrivals in Nepal increased from 0.9 million to 1.6 million with an average growth rate of above 15%. But this growth rate is declined by 1.5 as compared to the previous year. If Indian tourists are excluded the number decreased by 8.8% i.e. from 129330 in 1983 to 117917 in 1984 of the total visitor arrivals 176634. Western Europe continued to be a major market for travel to Nepal. It generated around 39% of the total visitor arrivals, 59767 visitors. North America 22134 arrivals (12.5%) Australia, Newzealand and Pacific 5647 arrivals (3.2%) and other areas 2498 arrivals (1.4%). However, Asia has turned into major new market in generating visitor arrivals (47.2%).

5.2 India's market share

In 1984, 33.2% of all visitors came from India and this number increased from 50102 to 58717. This figure includes only arrivals by air and constituted the highest percentage of incoming tourist traffic in Nepal. India still has the largest market share with 33.2% of the total visitor arrivals.

5.3 Other Markets

North American visitor arrivals decreased in 1984 by 2% over 1983 Australia, Newzealand and Pacific area by 44.5% in addition European tourist also went down by 10.2% in the same year. By nationalities USA occupies top generating market with 18627 visitors (10.5%) followed by U.K. 13188 (7.5%) France 12437 (7.1%) West Germany 10715 (6.1%) Japan 7439 (4.2%) and Australia 4512 (2.6%).

5.4 Modes of Transport

85% of total visitors came by air and 15% by land route in 1984 as previous year.

Among the air arrivals IAC increased its share from 42.6% in 1983 to 48.6% in 1984. At the same time RNAC's share decreased continuously from 28.3% to 24.8%. Thai international also decreased its share from 9.8% to 6.8%.

Though all scheduled carriers account for more than 99 percent of all air arrivals a sizeable number of visitors came by chartered flights.

5.5 Purpose of visit

The predominant motivation for travel to Nepal is pleasure (pleasure seeking sightseeing holiday making). Out of the total visitor arrivals in 1984 pleasure purpose accounted for 79.6 percent, trekking and mountaineering purpose 8.5 percent. The data on table no.18 and 28 shows the number of tourists coming for the trekking and mountaineering as the sources of the two tables are different the data also differ. The data of the table no.18 derived through the disembarkation

cards filled up by the tourists. The data in table no.28 shows the trekking permit issued by the central immigration office HMG, Nepal.

Nepal is gaining popularity as a trekker's Shangrila, because of its mountain and scenic beauties. The data on this report shows that the number of visitors coming for the trekking and mountaineering has constantly increased from the last eight years an average of 13% of all visitors as against 2.3 percent in 1973. Trekking figures do not include short treks around Kathmandu and Pokhara Valley. The number of trekkers who got permission for trekking increased by 27.6 percent over 1983. The number of trekking permits issued by the Central Immigration Office has also been shown separately in the report on the basis of trekking routes in table No. 28.

The card used before 1974 gave the visitors freedom to fill up a blank line with any purpose of visit. The card introduced in January 1974 require visitors to mark his purpose of visit out of a given set of five choices one of which is "Trekking and Mountaineering".

5.6 Port of Entry and Exit

The mainpoint for entering Nepal by-land used to be Birgunj. Now it has switched over to Bhairahawa, south of Pokhara for entry which is gaining importance. Bhairahawa has continued to predominate the port of exit by land route since 1977. It is interesting to note that more land travellers leave the country by air.

Most air visitors come from Delhi followed by Bankok and Banaras, Delhi is the important port of call for onward travelling tourists.

5.7 Duration of Stay

Average intended length of stay for the twelve months period from January to December 1984 is 11.8 days per visitor arrived in Nepal.

Average actual length of stay for the twelve months period from January to December 1984 is 10.6 days per visitor departed from Nepal.

5.8 Foreign Exchange Revenue

Gross foreign exchange earnings from tourism (as released by Nepal Rastra Bank) increased in the fiscal year 1983/84 by 19.3 percent but US\$ decreased from 32544000 as against US\$ 35071000 in 1982/83.

5.9 Nepali National Going Abroad

With the objective of providing some information on the movement of Nepali nationals going abroad, some tables have been added in this edition.

1962/1984

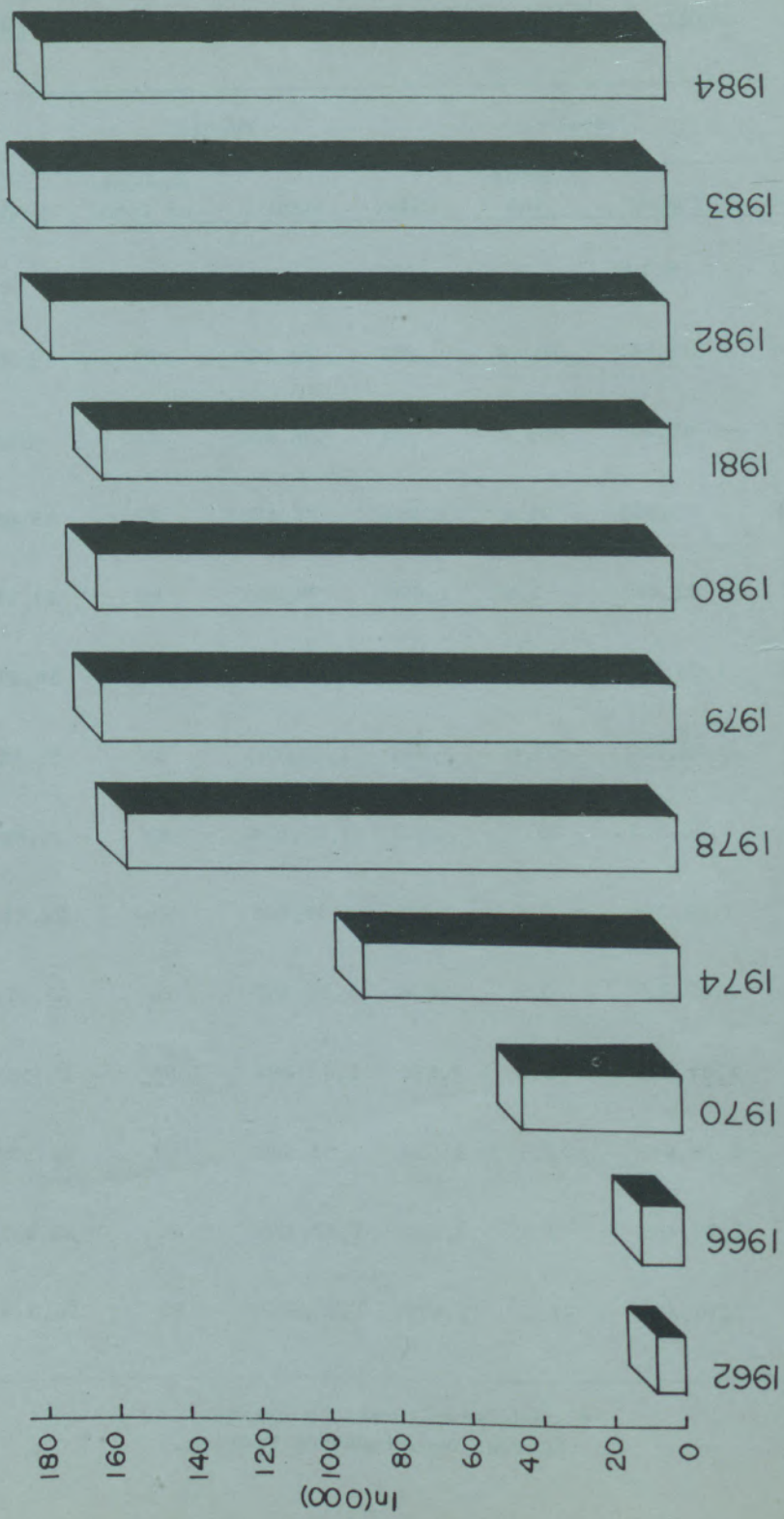

1961/62 - 1983/84

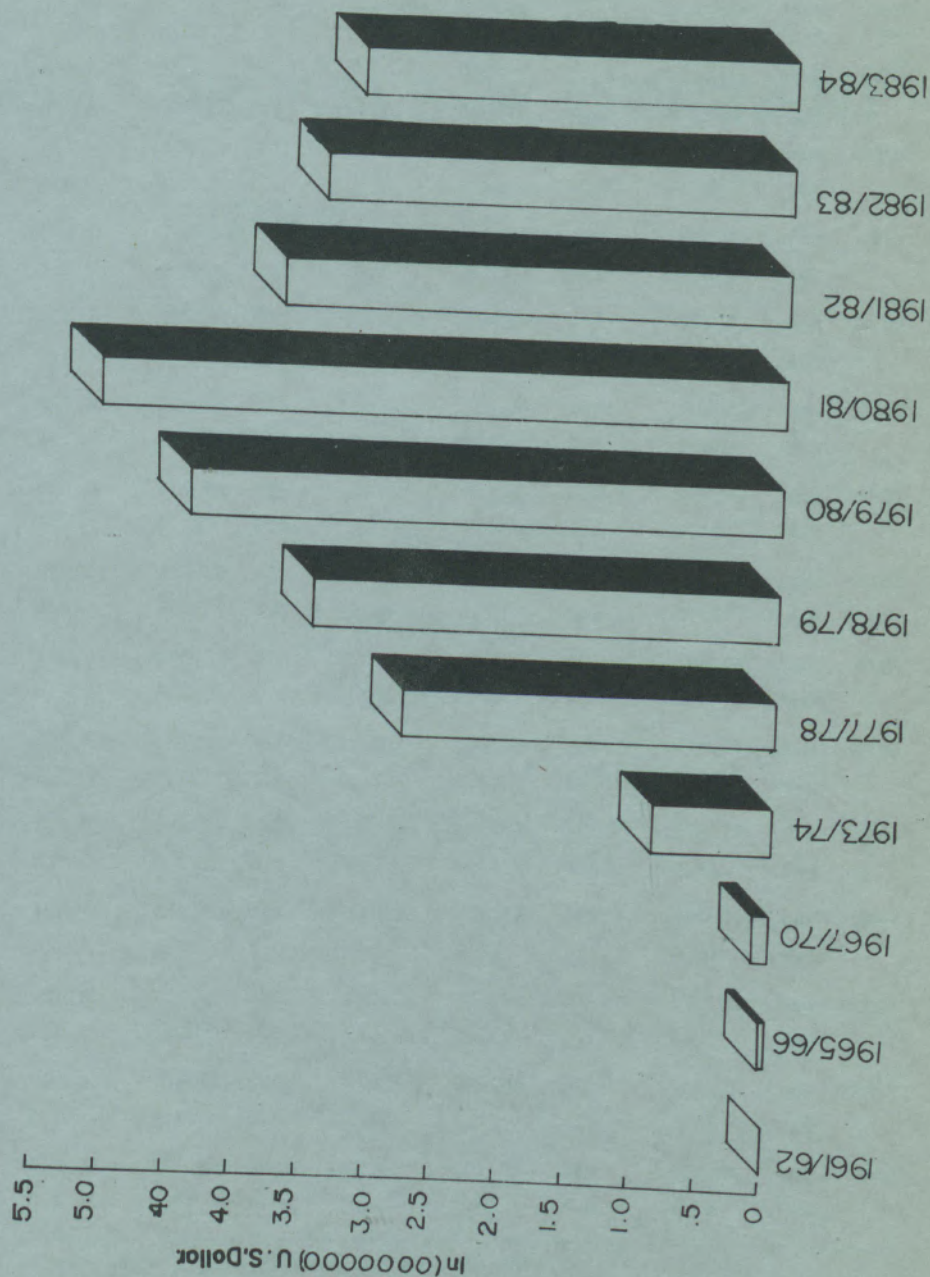

TOURIST ARRIVALS BY CONTINENT 1984

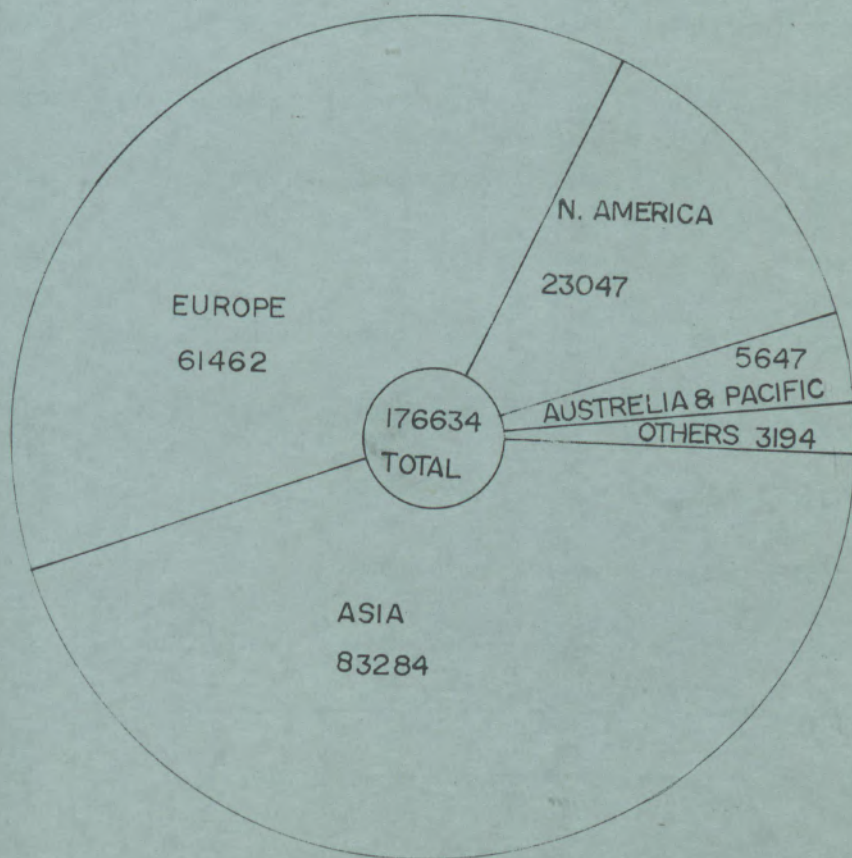

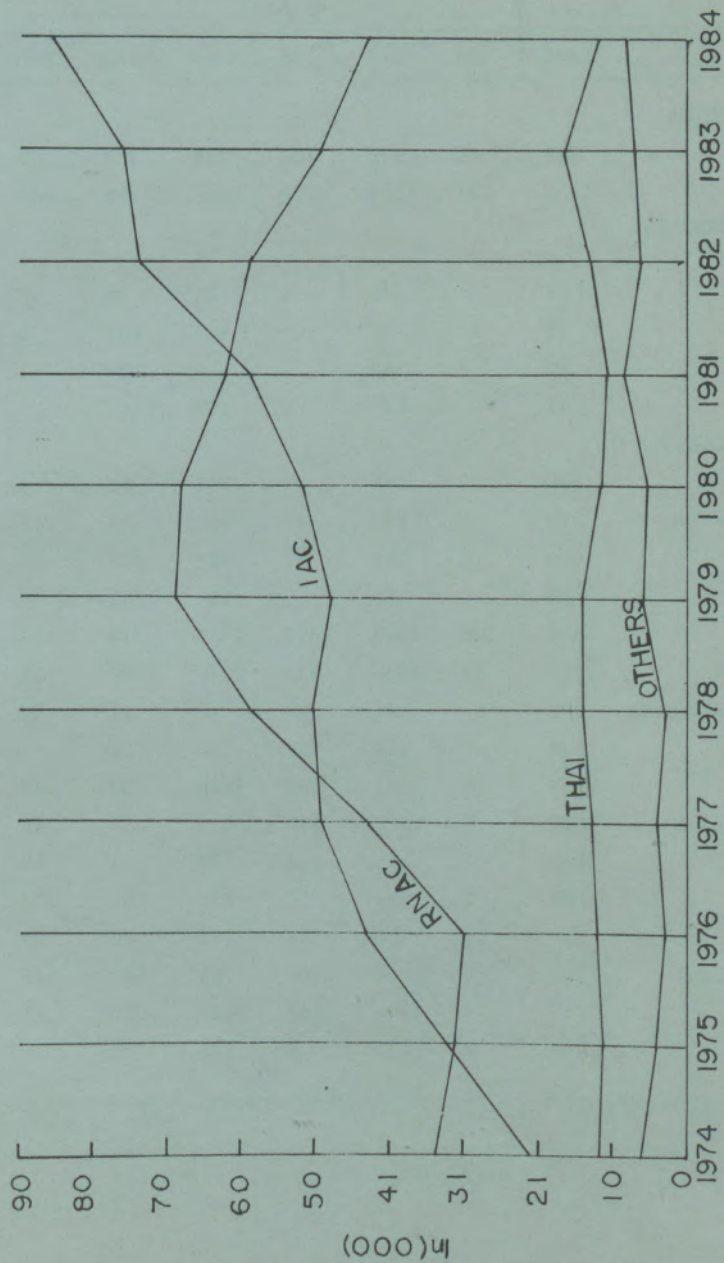

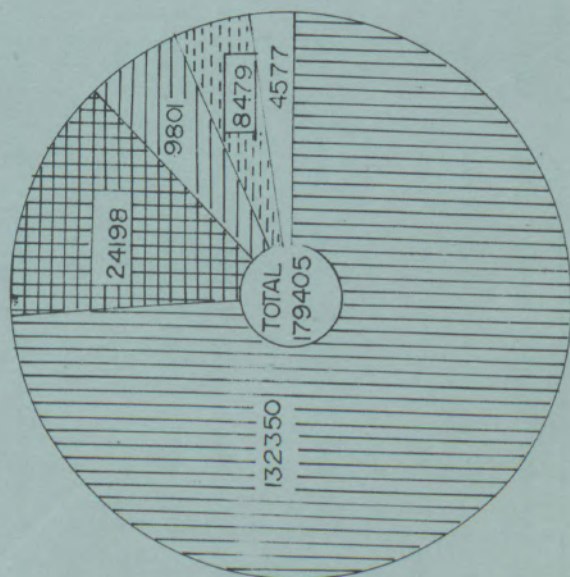

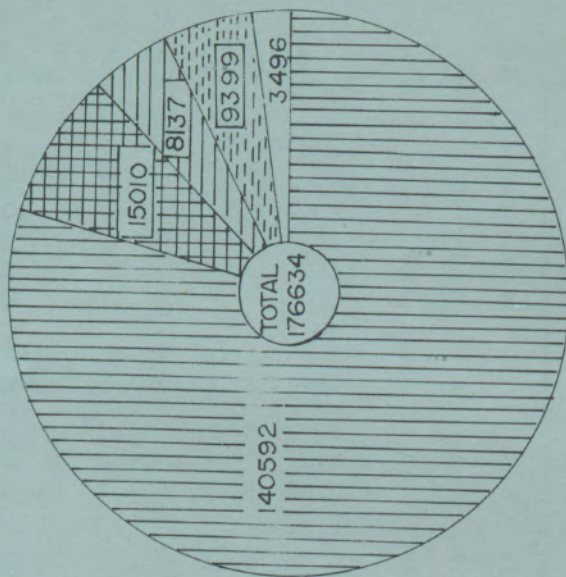

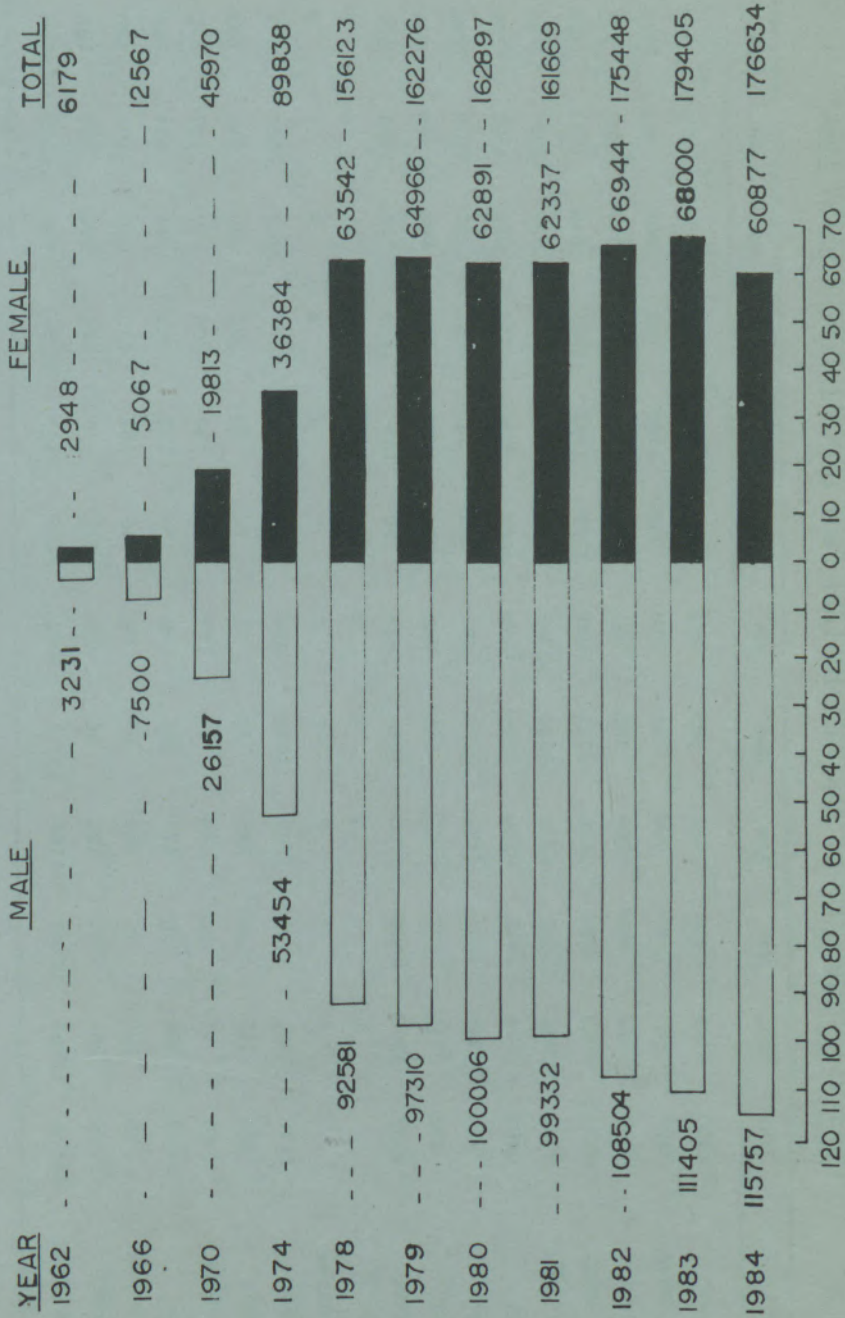

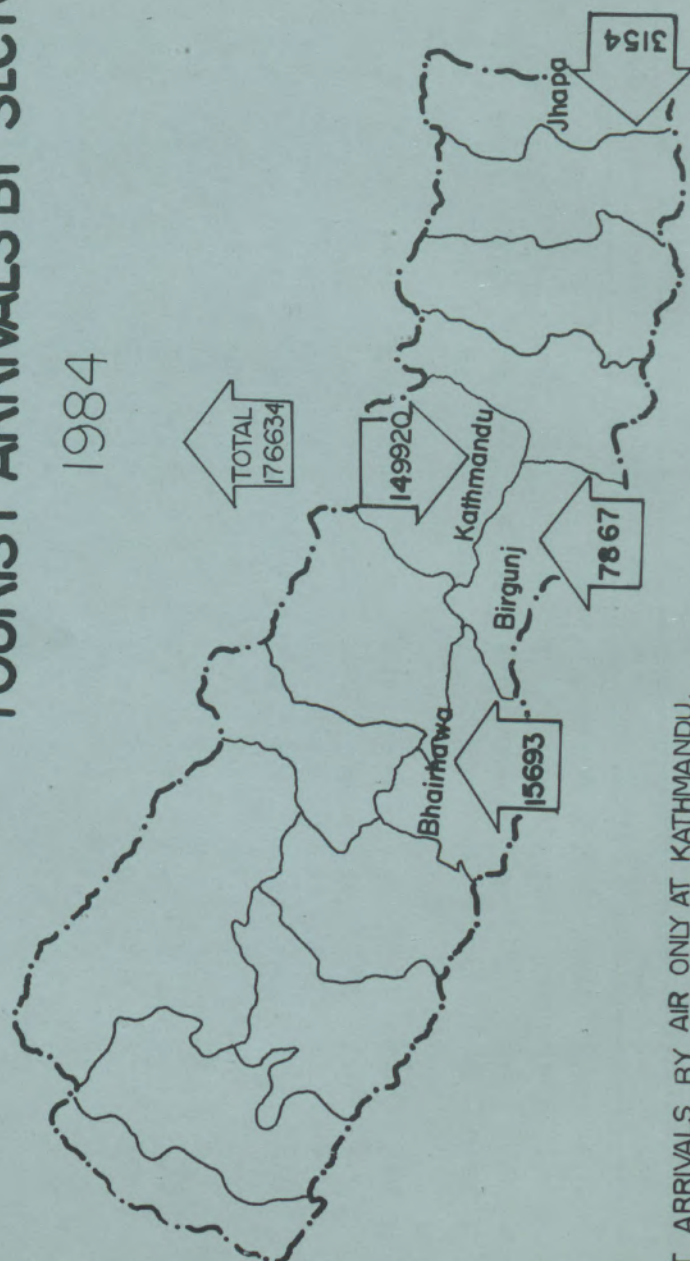
