

A. Introduction.

As per the UN Guidelines for Tourism Statistics 1971, the visitors are classified into two categories: 'Excursionist' - staying for less than 24 hours and, 'Tourist' - staying for over 24 hours or at least one night. For the preparation of this ' Statistical Report' Indian tourists coming by air and other tourists from third country coming by both air and surface traffics have been taken into consideration.

This report contains statistics relating to the tourists in terms of their nationality, country of residence, mode of transport, purpose of visit, age, sex and other relevant matters. It also includes the tourism receipt and availability of services in Nepal. The latter part of the report gives the information regarding Nepalese nationals visiting abroad.

B. Highlights of Tourism Related Activities.

The year 1987 was full of successful tourism related activities, as Nepal became the rendezvous of different regional meetings, seminar and national convention of which the first one was the Regional Meeting cum Seminar on "Heritage Conservation for Tourism Development" under the sponsorship of World Tourism Organization (WTO). The Regional Meeting cum Seminar was held in Kathmandu from March 30 to April 3, 1987, and was jointly organized by Commission for South Asia and Commission for East Asia and the Pacific under the World Tourism Organization. Similarly, the 36th National Convention of Travel Agents Association of India (TAAI) was also held in Kathmandu from April 30 to May 4, 1987. This was the second national convention of TAAI that was organized in Kathmandu the first one being held in 1979.

At the friendly invitation of Department of Tourism, a six member tourism delegation from the Tibet Region of the People's Republic of China visited Nepal from October 10 to 24, 1987. Several rounds of discussion were held and a Memorandum of Understanding was signed to promote tourism activities in both countries. Under the Memorandum of Understanding cross country trekking and extension of cooperation between tourism establishments in both countries were agreed in principle.

Nepal also participated in eight different international tourism fairs organized in different countries in order to boost up the tourism promotional activities. Likewise, Nepal's active participation in the 7th General Assembly of WTO held in Spain, 36th PATA Annual Conference held in Japan, PATA Board of Directors Meeting held in South Korea and PATA South Asia Chapters' meeting held in Srilanka are also notable events of the year 1987.

The ~~new~~ sky policy adopted by His Majesty's Government of Nepal so as to encourage the foreign airlines to operate in Kathmandu is one of the main highlights of 1987. Consequently, Singapore Airlines, Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) and Lufthansa started their operation in Kathmandu. The Singapore Airlines started its twice a week scheduled flights between Singapore and Kathmandu from July 6, 1987. The CAAC started weekly flights between Lhasa and Kathmandu from September 12, 1987. Similarly, Lufthansa Airlines of Federal Republic of Germany started its weekly flight between Frankfurt and Kathmandu from October 6, 1987 placing itself as the first airlines to have a direct airlink of Nepal with any European country. Moreover, charter flights of Condor also continued in the same year. The historical landing of the Concord aircraft of Air France and that of the Jumbo Jet Boeing 747 of Air Canada at Tribhuvan International Airport on October 12, 1987 and November 19, 1987 respectively were also some of the important happenings.

The contribution of Royal Nepal Airlines, the national flag carrier also remained very significant in 1987 as it added Karnali, a Boeing 757 aircraft with 16 Shangrila Executive Class seats for the first

time in its fleet. Royal Nepal Airlines also started its weekly flight between Kathmandu and Male, the capital of Maldives from October 3, 1987. With this extension the Airlines has now direct airlink with all the SAARC (South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation) countries except Bhutan. Furthermore, the Royal Nepal Airlines had some direct charter operation to Nagoya of Japan in December 1987.

The Industrial Enterprises Act had its second amendment in 1987. It further contributed to create conducive environment for more investment in tourism sector. In order to have a quality and efficient services from the agencies involved in tourism activities and to have increased participation of the private sector, His Majesty's Government adopted the liberal policy to simplify procedures on licensing of new travel and trekking agencies from August 20, 1987. Under this new arrangement a total of 19 travel agencies and 20 trekking agencies were registered in 1987. Similarly, several hotels were granted permission to be established in the same year. Nevertheless, two major hotels, Hotel Sherpa with 160 beds and Hotel Himalaya with 184 beds were also added in the Kathmandu Valley.

His Majesty's Government had formed a task force to formulate a long term tourism development plan and to study the future trend and facilities required for the growth. The task force has already submitted its first draft report and a one day seminar was held on October 18, 1987 to discuss and review the draft report.

From the point of view of international awards and medals too, the year 1987 remained very fruitful. A video film entitled 'Tale of Three Cities' produced by Department of Tourism with the cooperation of Nepal Television was awarded as the second best video film in the Sony Video Award for Cultural Promotion Contest held in Japan. A video film entitled "Nepal Where the Legends Live" was also made under the joint venture of Department of tourism, Royal Nepal Airlines and PATA Nepal Chapter. Similarly, Department of Tourism published a total number of 185,000 brochures and 39,000 pieces of posters in the Fiscal Year 2043/44 (1986/1987).

PART II

Summary of Tourism in Nepal

Summary of Tourism in Nepal in 1987

1. Tourist Arrivals.

Nepal received a total number of 248,080 tourists in 1987 as against the 223,331 of 1986. This represents an increase of 24,749 visitors or 11.1% over the previous year.

A. Arrivals by Region.

Among the overall tourist inflow in the Kingdom the Asian Continent constitutes 39.7%. Likewise, the arrivals from Western Europe, North America, Australia & the Pacific represent 37.1%, 12.7% and 5.6% respectively.

The individual annual increase over the previous year of Asian Continent is 16.2%. Similarly, North America, Western Europe, Australia & the Pacific and Africa registered the increase of 12.7%, 7.7%, 2.0% and 3.2% respectively over the year 1986.

By nationality, India remained the major tourist generating market as 58,964 visitors came from India. This figure accounts for 23.8% of the total number of tourists coming to Nepal in 1987. Then the USA stands the second major market by recording 26,474 visitors or 10.7% followed by the UK with the number of 18,814 tourists or 7.6%, West Germany 16,794 or 6.8%, Japan 16,280 or 6.6%, France 16,184 or 6.5%, and Australia 11,056 or 4.5% respectively.

B. Mode of Transport

Of the total visitors 82.9% entered Nepal by air. Among them Royal Nepal Airlines provided services to 40.7% followed by the Indian Airlines to 39.1% and Thai Airways to 11.6%. 17.1% tourists came Nepal by land route in 1987.

C. Purpose of Visit

The predominant motivation for travel to Nepal continued to remain pleasure. Out of the total visitor arrivals in 1987 pleasure purpose accounted for 74.6%, trekking and mountaineering purpose 14.6%. However, the actual number of trekkers according to the trekking permit issued represent 19.1% of the total arrivals.

D. Arrivals by Sex and Age

The contribution of male visitors comprises 61.5% as against that of the female visitors which is recorded 38.5%.

The age group between 16 and 30 comprises the largest number of tourists visiting Nepal with 33.6%. The second largest age group is between 31 and 45 with 31.8% followed by the age group of 46 to 60 with 18.8%. There is no significant change in arrivals by age group as compared to 1986.

E. Arrivals by Season

The month of October continued to be the most popular month for the visitors coming to Nepal as the record shows an increase of 5.5% over the same period of the previous year. The other major months of tourist attractions are November, December, February and March respectively.

2. Revenue from Tourism

Previously the revenue from tourism sector used to be computed only according to the Nepalese fiscal year. On this basis the total revenue during the Fiscal Year 1986/87 shows an increase of 30.4% over the Fiscal Year 1985/86. However from 1987 onwards a new tradition has been set as the revenue from tourism sector is also calculated in terms of English Calendar Year. The total revenue from this sector, thus, is US\$ 60229000 for the year 1987.

3. Tourist Services

In Nepal, there are 105 tourist hotels with a total of 3507 hotel rooms or 7244 hotel beds. In the Kathmandu Valley 71 hotels with 2844 rooms or 5819 beds are available at present while outside the Valley 34 hotels with 663 rooms or 1425 beds are available for the tourists.

The hotel occupancy rate during 1987 shows 46.2% in the Kathmandu Valley and 40.5% outside the Valley. The occupancy rate for 1986 was 41.8% and 29.4% respectively.

There are altogether 90 travel agencies and 87 trekking agencies in Nepal at present.

4. Departure of Nepalese Nationals.

During the year 1987, a total number of 52064 Nepalese nationals went abroad with a decline of 7.2% over the previous year. Import restriction and foreign currency limitation hold responsibility to some extent regarding the decline in outbound tourism.

By purpose, 29.3%, of the total outbound Nepalese travellers was official visit, 21% business, 19.7%, study and 30% others.

By destination 17% of the total outbound Nepalese headed for Bangkok, 10.2% for Hongkong, 5.3% for Bangladesh and 64.8% for India. It is to be noted that the statistics for the outbound Nepali travellers are available only for the next port of call.



TOURIST ARRIVALS 1986-87











TOURIST ARRIVALS BY CONTINENTS

TOURIST ARRIVALS BY RESIDENCE & NATIONALITY











