

A. Introduction

As per the UN Guidelines for Tourism Statistics 1971, the visitors are classified into two categories. 'Excursionist' - staying for less than 24 hours and, 'Tourist' - staying for over 24 hours or at least one night. For the preparation of this 'Statistical Report' Indian tourists coming by air and other tourists from third country coming by both air and surface traffics have been taken into consideration.

This report contains statistics relating to the tourists in terms of their nationality, country of residence, mode of transport, purpose of visit, age, sex and other relevant matters. It also includes the tourism receipt and availability of services in Nepal. The latter part of the report gives the information regarding Nepalese nationals visiting abroad.

B. Highlights of the Year

The year 1988 added another milestone to tourism sector in terms of various activities that have positive bearings on its growth and promotion. A four-member task force from Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA), at the request of Department of Tourism, visited Pokhara at the end of January to assess what had happened since 1975 when it was recommended for development into secondary destination area. Likewise, an expert from World Tourism Organisation (WTO) visited Nepal in March to make feasibility study of Srinagar in Palpa district for development into another important tourist destination within the country. Similarly one-member fact-finding mission of Asian Development Bank (ADB) visited Kathmandu from 22 November to 2 December 1988 for the proposed technical assistance for tourism development programme of Nepal. A memorandum of understanding was subsequently signed between His Majesty's Government (HMG) Department of Tourism and ADB.

Nepal participated at the 37th Annual Conference of PATA and its Board of Directors' Meeting held in Melbourne, Australia from April 17 to 21 as well as PATA Board of Directors' meeting and Active Government Members Meeting in Bangkok, Thailand during August, 1988. In the same manner, Nepal also participated at Tourism Promotion Seminar sponsored by Economic and Social Commission for Asia and Pacific (ESCAP), held from October 17 to 25 in Tokyo, Japan and the WTO Conference on Facilitation held in Madrid, Spain. With a view to boosting up tourism promotion in the international arena, Nepal actively took part in seven international tourism fairs held in various countries of the world during different months of 1988. While participating in various international gatherings on tourism promotion, special emphasis was led on joint promotional activities by incorporating Department of Tourism, Royal Nepal Airlines and private sector industries.

With a view to expanding the access to information for tourists travelling in remote areas also a new Tourist Information Centre was opened at Jomosom of Mustang district in Dhaulagiri Zone in 1988. With this addition, the number of Tourist Information Centres in various parts of the Kingdom totals eight.

Climbers from China, Japan and Nepal added a new milestone in the history of mountaineering on May 5, 1988 by simultaneously scaling Sagarmatha (Mt. Everest) from the North and South sides and later cross-traversing the 8,848 meter peak. Millions of people all over the world watched the event on television with an unprecedented excitement. The tripartite expedition will go on history not only as the first occasion when simultaneous climbing and cross-traversing was done but also as the one with the largest number of members in it, putting a record number of twelve climbers on the summit in any single attempt. Two other climbers including the veteran mountaineer Sungdare Sherpa Climbed five days later. It.

was Sungdare's fifth ascent of the top of the world, a feat paralleled by none in the world so far. The live telecast from the summit of Sagarmatha was yet another highlight of this unique endeavour.

Nepal made an unique and impressive participation during the six-month long World Expo'88 held in Brisbane of Australia. At the invitation of the Government of Australia their Royal Highnesses Prince Gyanendra Bir Bikram Shah and Princess Komal Rajya Laxmi Devi Shah took part in the celebrations organised to mark Nepal's National Day at Expo'88 on September 19,1988. His Royal Highness the Prince also addressed at Nepal's National Day Function. The entourage had also included representatives from Ministry of Tourism and Department of Tourism.

The national flag carrier Royal Nepal Airlines (RNAC) continued to broaden its horizon in 1988 too. Subsequently, it started scheduled operation of charter flights between Kathmandu and Lhasa from April 1988. Similarly, RNAC started its first European flight to Frankfurt of West Germany via Dubai from October 1, 1988. With the addition of Frankfurt on RNAC's network, the airline now serves 12 cities of 11 countries in Asia and Europe. The start of this service to Frankfurt by RNAC is expected to promote tourism ties between Nepal and Europe which is one of the major markets of Nepal. Besides the contribution of RNAC became more significant after it acquired Gandaki, a second Boeing 757 to add to its existing fleet.

Royal Nepal Airlines, official inaugural flight of the Kathmandu-Frankfurt-Kathmandu sector took off on December 8,1988. Their Royal Highnesses Prince Gyanendra Bir Bikram Shah and Princess Komal Rajya Laxmi Devi Shah were on board the inaugural flight.


Nepal did not lag behind to win the international awards and medals in 1988 too. On the occasion of the 37th Annual Conference of PATA held in Melbourne, Australia, Nepal was awarded two prestigious gold medals. A video film titled — "Nepal where the Legends Live" bagged gold medal for the best travel video for the year 1987. The video film was produced under the joint venture of Department of Tourism, Royal Nepal Airlines Corporation and PATA Nepal Chapter. Nepal also bagged "Spirit of PATA" - another gold medal in honour of the excellent performance of PATA Nepal Chapter during the year 1987.

Department of Tourism published a total number of 186,500 brochures and 40,000 pieces of posters in the fiscal year 2044/45 (1987/88).

Under the Industrial Enterprises Act a total of 12 trekking agencies and 10 travel agencies were granted permission for establishment during 1988. Similarly a total of 15 hotels also were granted permission to be established in the same year.

Part II

Summary of Tourism in Nepal



Summary of Tourism in Nepal in 1988

1. TOURIST ARRIVALS.

Nepal received a total number of 265,943 tourists in 1988 as against the 248,080 of 1987. This represents an increase of 17,863 visitors or 7.2% over the previous year.

A. Arrivals by Region.

Among the overall tourist inflow in the Kingdom the Asian Continent constitutes 42.9%. Likewise, the arrivals from Western Europe, North America, Australia & the Pacific represent 37.5%, 11.4% and 5.1% respectively.

The individual annual increase over the previous year of Asian Continent is 15.7%. Similarly, Western Europe and Africa registered an increase of 8.4% and 10.0% respectively over the year 1987. On the contrary tourist inflow from North America & Australia & the Pacific decreased by 3.6% & 1.4% respectively as compared with that of the preceding year.

By nationality, India remained the major tourist generating market as 72,058 visitors came from India. This figure accounts for 27.1% of the total number of tourists coming to Nepal in 1988. Then the USA stands as the second major market by recording 25,525 visitors or 9.6% followed by the UK with the number of 19,969 tourists or 7.5%, West Germany 19,865 or 7.5%, Japan 17,324 or 6.5%, France 15,446, or 5.8% and Australia 11,006 or 4.1% respectively.

B Mode of Transport

Of the total visitors 88.3% entered Nepal by air. Among them Royal Nepal Airlines provided services to 43.4% followed by the Indian Airlines to 36.9% and Thai Airways to 10.5%. About 11.7% tourists came Nepal by land route in 1988.

C Purpose of Visit

The predominant motivation for travel to Nepal continued to remain pleasure. Out of the total visitor arrivals in 1988 pleasure purpose accounted for 75.5%, trekking and mountaineering purpose 13.9%. However, the actual number of trekkers according to the trekking permit issued represent 23.0% of the total arrivals.

D Arrivals by Sex and Age

The contribution of male visitors comprises 62.5% as against that of the female visitors which is recorded 37.5%.

The age group between 16 and 30 comprises the largest number of tourists visiting Nepal with 32.4%. The second largest age group is between 31 and 45 with 32.2% followed by the age group of 46 to 60 with 19.2 %. There is no significant change in arrivals by age group as compared to 1987.

E Arrivals by Season

The month of October continued to be the most popular month for the visitors coming to Nepal as the record shows an increase of 9.0% over the same period of the previous year. The other major months of tourist attractions are November, December, February and March respectively.

2. REVENUE FROM TOURISM

Before 1987 the revenue from tourism sector used to be computed only according to the Nepalese fiscal year. From 1987 onwards a new tradition has been set as the revenue from tourism sector is also calculated in terms of English Calendar Year. The total revenue from this sector, thus, is US\$ 63,502,000 for the year 1988.

3. TOURIST SERVICES

In Nepal, there are 120 tourist hotels with a total of 3,996 hotel rooms or 8011 hotel beds. In the Kathmandu Valley 75 hotels with 3,098 rooms or 6,125 beds are available at present while outside the Valley 45 hotels with 898 rooms or 1,886 beds are available for the tourists.


The hotel occupancy rate during 1988 shows 39.8% in the Kathmandu Valley and 37.4% outside the Valley. Their occupancy rate for 1987 was 46.2% and 40.5% respectively.

There are altogether 99 travel agencies and 99 trekking agencies in Nepal at present.

4. DEPARTURE OF NEPALESE NATIONALS.

During the year 1988, a total number of 62,218 Nepalese nationals went abroad with an increase of 19.5% over the previous year.

By destination 19.8% of the total outbound Nepalese headed for Bangkok, 11.6% for HongKong, 4.6% for Bangladesh and 61.6% for India. It is to be noted that the statistics for the outbound Nepali travellers are available only for the next port of call.

TOURIST ARRIVALS 1962 - 1988



TOURIST ARRIVALS 1987 - 1988



TOURIST ARRIVALS BY FISCAL YEAR 1978/79 - 1987/88







TOURIST ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT 1988







GROSS FOREIGN EXCHANGE 1961/62 - 1987/88






