




A. Introduction

As per the UN Guidelines for Tourism Statistics 1971, the visitors are classified into two categories. 'Excursionist' - staying for less than 24 hours and, 'Tourist' - staying for over 24 hours or atleast one night. For the preparation of this 'Statistical Report' Indian tourists coming by air and other tourists from third country coming by both air and surface traffics have been taken into consideration.

This report contains statistics relating to the tourists in terms of their nationality, country of residence, mode of transport, purpose of visit, age, sex and other relevant matters. It also includes the tourism receipt and availability of services in Nepal. The latter part of the report gives the information regarding Nepalese nationals visiting abroad.

B. Highlights of the Year

Tourism in Nepal was not very smooth during 1990. Both domestic and international factors were responsible for the cause. The Gulf crisis that started in August with serious effect on international tourism, naturally caused some setback on Nepalese tourism also. The popular movement of the people which ended in the restoration of democracy in April had also some impact on tourist arrivals. However, the tourism sector of Nepal was quite eventful and its performance satisfactory during the year.

In realisation of the rich and diverse adventure travel opportunities available in Nepal, the Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) co-operated with His Majesty's Government to organise the second PATA Adventure Travel Conference and Mart in Kathmandu from January 31 to February 2. The conference was participated by 151 delegates and the Mart by 30 sellers and 53 buyers respectively. The first event of the kind was also held in Kathmandu in January, 1989.

A comprehensive study to provide a longer term strategy for tourism development in Nepal was carried out with the grant assistance of Asian Development Bank (ADB). A seminar participated by Government, Royal Nepal Airlines and the private sector was organised to review the findings of the study on Feb 5, 1990. Its final report entitled "Nepal Tourism Development Programme" which is in four volumes was prepared in June 1990. It brought so much ripples in the private sector that Nepal Association of Travel Agents (NATA), under the joint auspices of HMG and ADB, organised a seminar on the theme of "Investment Opportunities in Tourism in Nepal" to mark its silver Jubilee in the first week of December. The seminar was attended by 231 participants, 18 of them from foreign countries. A booklet providing the profiles of some of the ready-at-hand tourism projects in the line of ADB report, together with an account of investment incentives provided by His Majesty's Government, was brought out during the seminar which also marked the 8th National convention of NATA.

A study of proposed conservation area of Ram Krishna Tole in Pokhara was carried out by PATA in 1990. Similarly, studies of Pashupatinath Area in Kathmandu and Rasuwa district, north of the valley, were also carried out through local efforts with the objective of developing tourism.

A two-member delegation from USSR visited Nepal in February to discuss with the Nepalese counterparts ways and means to promote tourism between the two countries. A memorandum of understanding was signed between the two countries in this regard on February 28.

The new International Terminal Building of Tribhuvan International Airport was inaugurated by His Majesty the King on February 18. The new complex which retains the features of typical Nepalese artistic tradition has a capacity of handling 1060 passengers per hour.

Department of Tourism took part in the 39th Annual Conference of PATA and PATA World Chapters Congress held in Vancouver, Canada between April 20 and 26.

Special arrangements were made for tourists for observation of Kathmandu valleys' two most important cultural festivals namely "Gai Jatra" and "Indra Jatra" during August and September.

The newly elected president and executive vice president, Mr. Pierre Dooley and Mr. Kane Rufe of PATA visited Nepal in August at the cordial invitation of His Majesty's Government.

A tourism delegation from Tibet Autonomous Region of the Republic of China visited Nepal in December to have bilateral talks with the Nepalese counterparts.

To mark the occasion of World Tourism Day on September 27, hotels of different classified categories, travel agencies and trekking agencies topping in foreign currency earning in their respective sectors were honoured with trophies and certificates.

Aeroflot started its regular operation between Kathmandu and Moscow from August 15, adding one more name on the list of on-line international airlines operating in Kathmandu.

A group of 11 Indian journalists visited Nepal under the joint aegis of Hotel Soaltee Oberai and PATA Nepal Chapter in January. They were apprised of the contemporary tourism situation of Nepal. Following the restoration of status quo ante in transit and trade agreement with India, a group of 37 eminent Indian Travel writers and Agents representatives were also invited in September. HMG also hosted the visit of a prominent travel writer of "The Telegraph" published from UK in the month of September.

The Everest View Hotel, popularly known as the hotel at the highest elevation of the world, re-opened for tourists in October 1990 after renovation.

Department of Tourism was also involved in the formulation of national guidelines for Environmental Impact Assessment of development projects under the joint auspices of National Planning Commission and IUCN (World Conservation Union).

A one-day seminar "Tourism Trade and marketing Strategies" was organised in October to apprise the Nepalese tourism personnels of modern techniques in tourism marketing. An expert from Belgium, Dr. Norbert Vanhove, conducted the seminar.

A successful para-gliding test operation was carried out from Champadevi hill in the west of Kathmandu valley. There were 5 German and 2 trained Nepali guides to para-glide down the hill.

Nepal covered 11 of the international tourism related fairs or conferences during the year. Among the originating countries, USA, UK, Germany, India, Canada, Korea, Hong Kong, Switzerland, Sweden and Finland were covered for promotion. In promotional events like ITB, Berlin and World Travel

Market, London, joint participation of the Department of Tourism, Royal Nepal Airlines and the private sector was even more enhanced than previous years.

The Department of Tourism published travel advertisements in 18 different travel magazines and papers published within the country or abroad.

Department of Tourism produced 4,43,000 pieces of publicity materials which included brochures, booklets, posters, stickers, bags and batches.

Altogether 17 hotels, 26 travel agencies and 24 trekking agencies were registered during the year.

PART II

Summary of Tourism in Nepal

Summary of Tourism, 1990

1. TOURIST ARRIVALS

A total of 254,885 tourists visited Nepal in 1990, which represents 6.2% increase over 1989.

There was an impressive growth of Indian tourists, accounting for 38.1% over the last year. Number of tourists from overseas countries declined slightly by 0.8%.

The average length of stay per visitor is 12 days.

A. Arrivals by Region

Tourists from Western Europe constitute the highest share of 43.5% among all the continents. The arrivals from Asia, North America and Australia & Pacific represent 38.6%, 10.3% and 5.2% respectively.

B. Mode of Transport

Visitors entering by air constitute 86.6% of the total arrivals, whereas those entering by land stand at 13.4%.

C. Arrivals by sex and Age

The male visitors comprise 60.9% as against 39.1% of female visitors in 1990.

By age group, the highest share goes to the group of 16 to 30 years, comprising 33.7% of the total arrivals. It is closely followed by 31 to 45 age group, constituting 32.3% of the total.

D. Purpose of visit

Like in the past years, the predominant motivation for travel to Nepal continues to remain pleasure in 1990 also. Pleasure visitors account for 63.5% of the total arrivals.

E. Trekkers

There was a rise of 2.0% in the number of trekkers in 1990. Out of 62,092 trekkers, 42.4% were handled through registered trekking agencies. A total of 36,361 trekkers visited Annapurna area while Everest and Langtang treks were used by 18.2% and 12.6% respectively.

F. Mountaineers.

A total of 120 expedition teams were granted permission to climb different Himalayan peaks during 1990, out of which only 56 teams were successful in their attempts.

G. Visitors to Pokhara & Chitwan.

Pokhara was visited by over 59 thousand non-Indian visitors in 1990, which constitutes around one-third of the total non-Indian travellers coming to Nepal during the year. Similarly, there were 29,991 or 16.12% of the total non-Indian visitors to Chitwan valley during 1990.

2. REVENUE FROM TOURISM

Tourism contributes approximately 3.7% to the GDP of the nation. The total revenue generated from the sector in 1990 stands at US\$ 63,701 which shows a decrease of 6.8% over the previous year. The per capita expenditure of the visitor per day in Nepal decreased slightly as compared to the last year to stand at US\$ 27.2.

3. TOURISM SERVICES

The total number of tourist hotels in 1990 is 168, of which 97 are based in the Kathmandu valley and the rest in out-stations like Pokhara and Chitwan. The total number of rooms available in those hotels is 5,144 and the beds 10,244. Kathmandu valley accounts for 3,879 rooms with 7,626 beds, whereas the hotels outside the valley account for 1,269 rooms with 2,618 beds. Thus, the year 1990 registered an increase of 5.7% in number of hotels, 5.5% in rooms and 8.8% in number of beds.

The numbers of travel and trekking agencies in 1990 stand at 104 and 100 respectively.

4. DEPARTURE OF NEPALESE NATIONALS

A total of 82,452 Nepalese nationals went abroad during 1990. This number is an increase of 24.3% over the previous year.












TOURIST ARRIVALS BY SEX

TOURIST ARRIVAL BY PURPOSE OF VISIT, 1990












