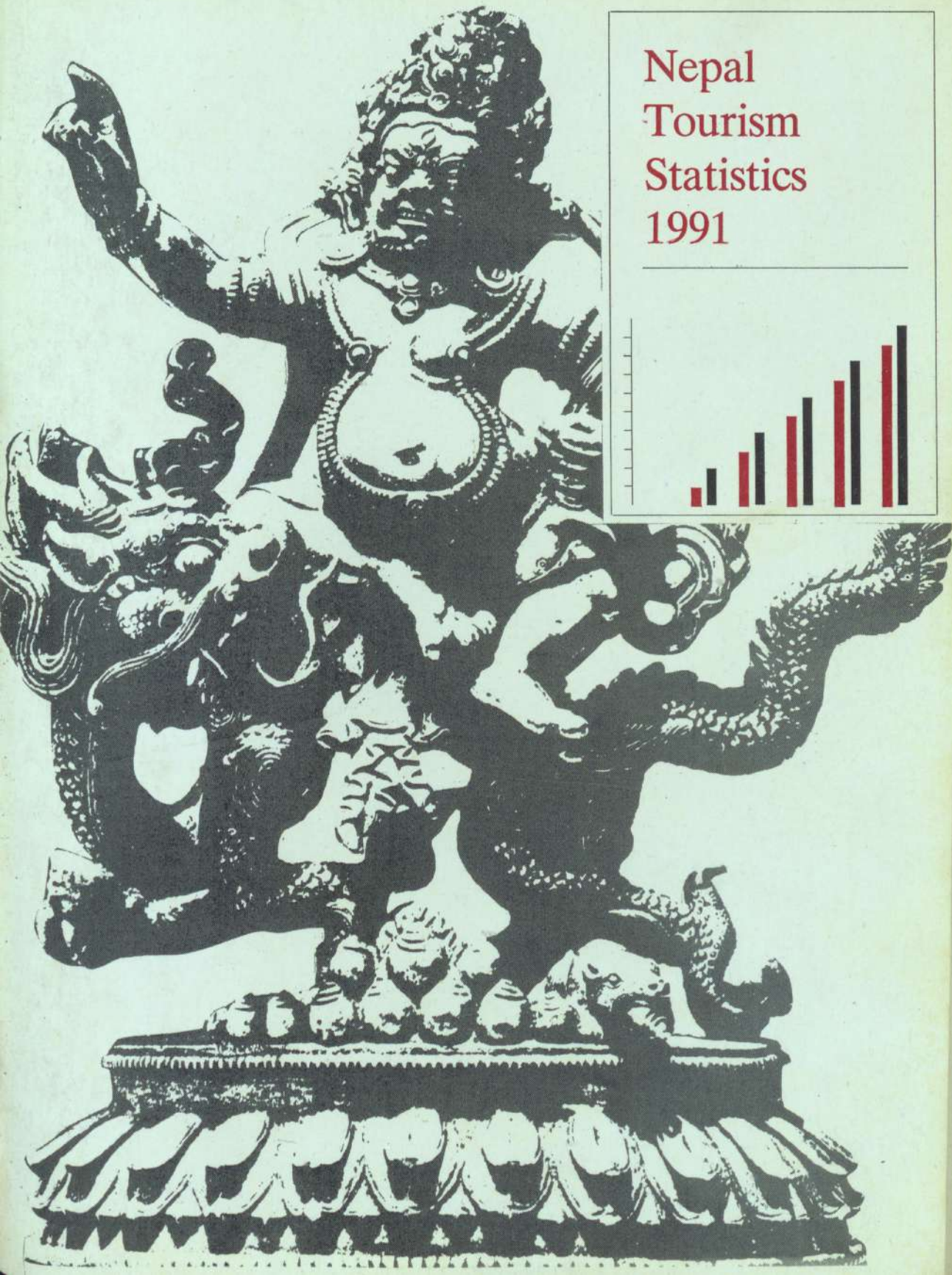
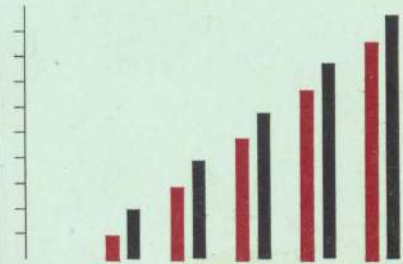

Highlights of Tourism Related Activities

A. Introduction

As per the UN Guidelines for Tourism Statistics 1971, the visitors are classified into two categories. 'Excursionist' -staying for less than 24 hours and, 'Tourist' - staying for over 24 hours or at least one night. For the preparation of this 'Statistical Report' Indian tourists coming by air and other tourists from third country coming by both air and surface traffics have been taken into consideration.

This report contains statistics relating to the tourists in terms of their nationality, country of residence, mode of transport, purpose of visit, age, sex and other relevant matters. It also includes the gross tourism receipts and availability of services in Nepal, The latter part of the report gives the information regarding Nepalese nationals visiting abroad.

B. Highlights of the Year

Tourism in Nepal was moderately satisfactory despite the Gulf War crisis in the beginning of 1991. With democracy restored and elected government in office, Nepal started to focus on economic development. Tourism being one of the principal sources for national development, new avenues for its growth and promotion were sought. Major attention was paid to remove the constraints facing the tourism sector, to diversify the products and promote foreign investment in this sector.

A Small Hotel Operations Training was conducted in Kathmandu from January 7 to 18 under the joint auspices of World Tourism Organization (WTO) and United Nations Development Program (UNDP). The training course was attended by 16 participants from 8 South Asian Countries including Burma.

In order to arouse consciousness about the deadly disease of AIDS which is fast spreading in the world through rapid movements of the people, a national level seminar was organized on January 29. Altogether 68 persons from different walks of life attended the seminar.

With active cooperation of PATA, ten travel writers from UK, Canada, Hong Kong, France, Japan and Australia visited Nepal on a Familiarization trip in February.

Department of Tourism actively participated in a workshop to formulate Environment Impact Assessment guidelines for the Kingdom of Nepal in February.

Three more entry points for tourists on the Nepal-India border were announced in March. Following the opening of Rupadiya, Gauriphanta and Banbasa entry points on the Indian side, Vis-a-vis Nepalganj, Dhangadhi and Mahendranagar on Nepalese border, total number of such points stands at six.

In an effort to diversify training opportunities beyond Kathmandu valley, a monthlong training for trekking guides was conducted in Pokhara from February 15 under the joint auspices of Hotel Management and Tourism Training Centre (HMTTC), UNDP and ILO. Altogether 35 persons attended the training program. A workshop on Marketing in Tourism was organized from March 10 to 17 under the joint aegis of HMTTC, UNDP and ILO to disseminate some new ideas about marketing tools among the concerned circle.

To create more awareness about the fragile mountain environment, the Nepal Mountaineering Association (NMA) organized a one-day seminar on Himalayan Environment on March 13.

His Majesty's Government simplified the procedures and liberalized incentive scheme for foreign investments. Attempts to promote foreign investments especially in capital intensive and innovative tourism projects were made through different print media.

A team from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) visited Nepal in August for the appraisal of Tourism Infrastructure Development Project to be financed from the bank. A Memorandum of understanding pertaining to the \$ 10.4 million loan project was signed between HMG and the Bank on August 23.

The Hotel Association of Nepal (HAN) celebrated its silver jubilee in the first week of September by organizing a variety of programmes. A seminar on "Tourism for Development" on September 3 was one of the highlights of the HAN programmes.

In September His Majesty's Government made announcement to open more of the Himalayan regions for trekking activities with a view to diversify trekking products. High Himalayan and trans-Himalayan areas like Manaslu, Upper Mustang and Upper Dolpa were consequently accessible for group trekkers on a controlled basis.

Nepal hosted the 5th PATA Asia Chapters Meeting from September 18 to 20 under the joint auspices of Department of Tourism and PATA Nepal Chapter. Altogether 114 participants, comprising of 106 delegates from 14 countries attended the international meeting.

The Minister for Tourism led a 3-member delegation to the 9th General Assembly of the World Tourism Organization held in Buenos Aires, Argentina from October 27 to November 1. On the Occasion, Nepal also took part in the 2nd Steering Committee of the South Asia Tourism Year and 26th meeting of the Commission for South Asia.

With a view to promote cultural tourism which is one of the major assets for Nepal, special arrangements were made for tourists to view the Kumari Chariot festival and other cultural

performances on Indra Jatra Festival, October 22. A separate traditional masked dance competition was held for tourists at the Nasal Chowk of the historic Hunuman Dhoka Place to mark the occasion.

The secretary General of WTO, Mr. Antonio Enriquez Savignac paid official visit to Nepal from November 13 to 17 at the invitation of the Honorable Minister for Tourism.

The Director General led the Nepalese delegation to Youth Tourism Conference held in New Delhi from November 18 to 21.

In realization of the constraint faced by tourism sector for internal movement, Ministry of Tourism for the first time allowed the operation of air service in the private sector. Under this liberalized government policy, 2 air-operators and one helicopter service were established in 1991.

The Department of Tourism took part in 11 international promotion campaigns including tourism fairs, seminars, conferences etc., advertised in six different national and international print media and provided hospitality to travel related experts three times. Altogether 23 trekking agencies, 42 travel agencies and 58 hotels were licensed during the period.

PART II

Summary of Tourism in Nepal

Summary of Tourism 1991

1. TOURIST ARRIVALS

A total of 292,995 tourists visited Nepal in 1991 which represents 15 % increase over 1990.

There was an impressive growth of Indian tourists coming by Air only, accounting for 54.8 % over the last year. Number of tourists from overseas countries registered a modest increase of 2.8 %.

The average length of stay per visitor went down to 9.3 days.

A Arrivals by Region

Tourist from Asia constitute the highest share of 47.8 % among all the continents. The arrivals from Western Europe, North America and Australia and Pacific represent 37.7 %, 8.2 % and 3.6 % respectively.

B Mode of Transport

Visitors entering by air constitute 91.4 % of the total arrivals, whereas those entering by land stand at 8.6 %.

C Arrivals by sex and Age

The male visitors comprise 60.6 % as against 39.4 % female visitors in 1991.

By age group, the highest share goes to the group of 16 to 30 years, comprising 33.0 % of the total arrivals. It is closely followed by 31 to 45 age group, constituting 32.3 % of the total.

D Purpose of visit

Like in the past years, the predominant motivation for travel to Nepal continues to remain pleasure in 1991 also. Pleasure visitors account for 60.5 % of the total arrivals.

E Trekkers

There was a rise of 5.9 % in the number of trekkers in 1991. Out of 65770 trekkers, 48 % were handled through registered trekking agencies. A total of 39107 trekkers visited Annapurna area while Everest and Langtang treks were used by 18.0 % and 14.6 % respectively.

F Mountaineers

A total of 130 expedition teams were granted permission to climb different Himalayan peaks during 1991, out of which only 54 teams were successful in their attempts.

G Visitors to Pokhara

Pokhara was visited by over 62 thousand non-Indian visitors in 1991, which constitutes around one-third of the total non-Indian travellers coming to Nepal during the year.

2. REVENUE FROM TOURISM

Tourism contributes approximately 3.6 % to the GDP of the nation. The total revenue generated from the sector in 1991 stands at US\$ 58,589 which shows a decrease of 8.0 % over the previous year.

3. TOURISM SERVICES

The total number of tourist hotels in 1991 is 192, of which 106 are based in the Valley and the rest in out-stations like Pokhara and Chitwan. The total number of rooms available in those hotels are 5602 and the beds 11,207. Kathmandu accounts for 4,134 rooms with 8,162 beds, whereas the hotels outside the valley account for 1,468 rooms with 3,045 beds. Thus, the year 1991 registered an increase of 14.3 % in number of hotels, 8.9 % in rooms and 9.4 % in number of beds.

The numbers of travel and trekking agencies in 1991 stand at 194 and 162 respectively.

4. DEPARTURE OF NEPALESE NATIONALS

A total of 105,872 Nepalese nationals went abroad during 1991. This number is an increase of 28.4 % over the previous year.

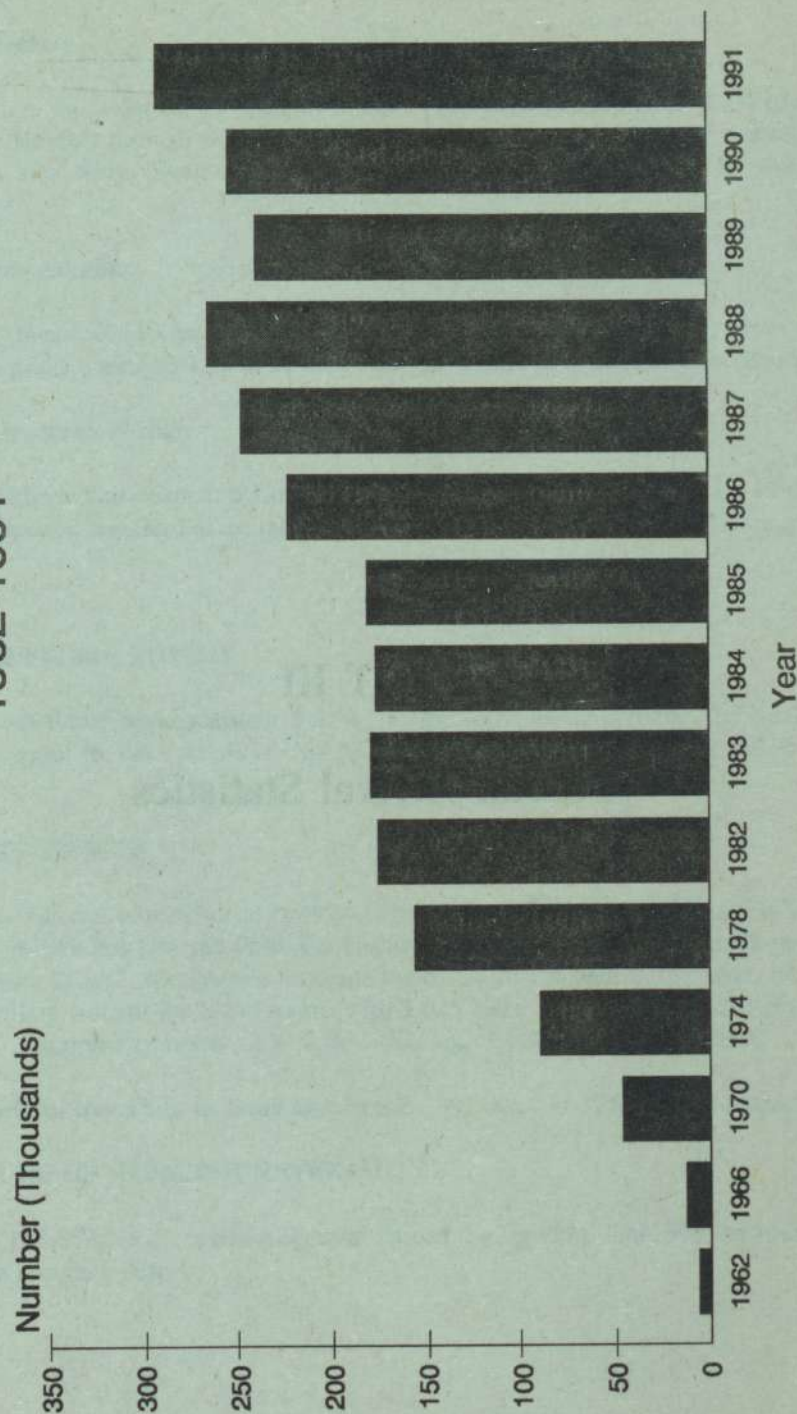

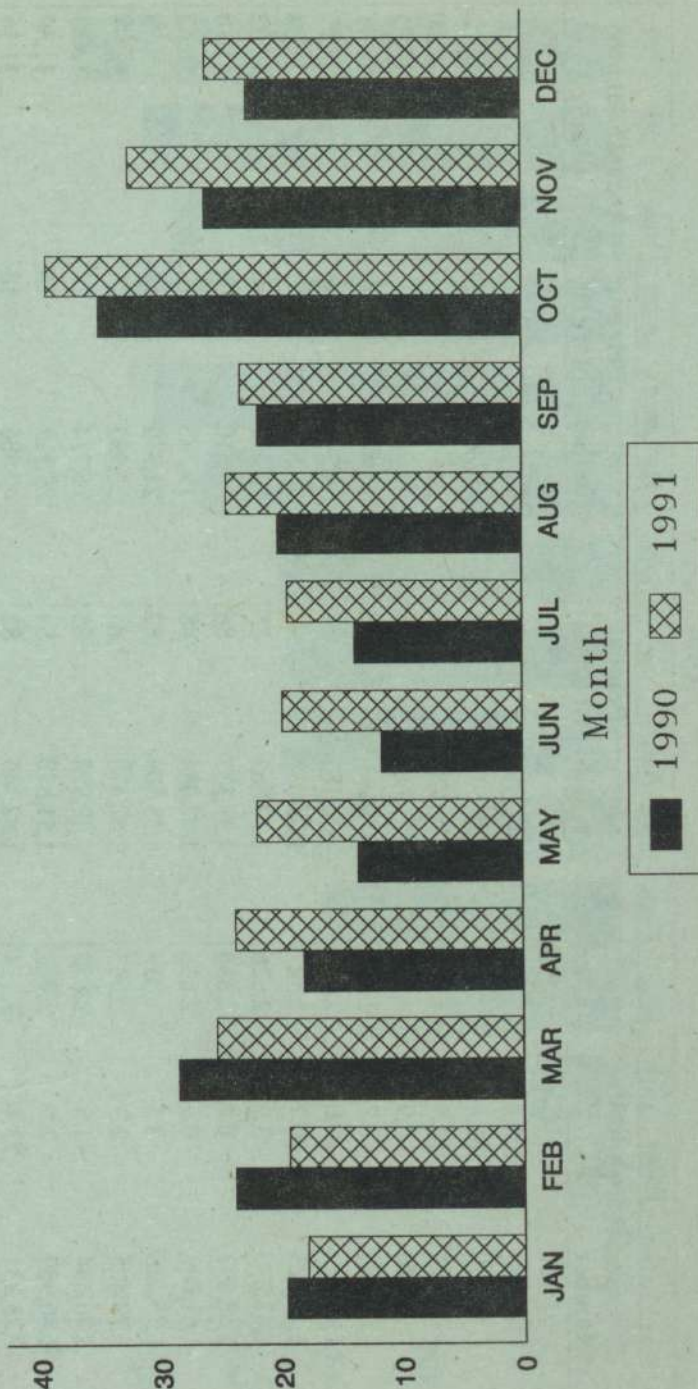

TOURIST ARRIVALS BY FISCAL YEAR 1980/81 - 1990/91

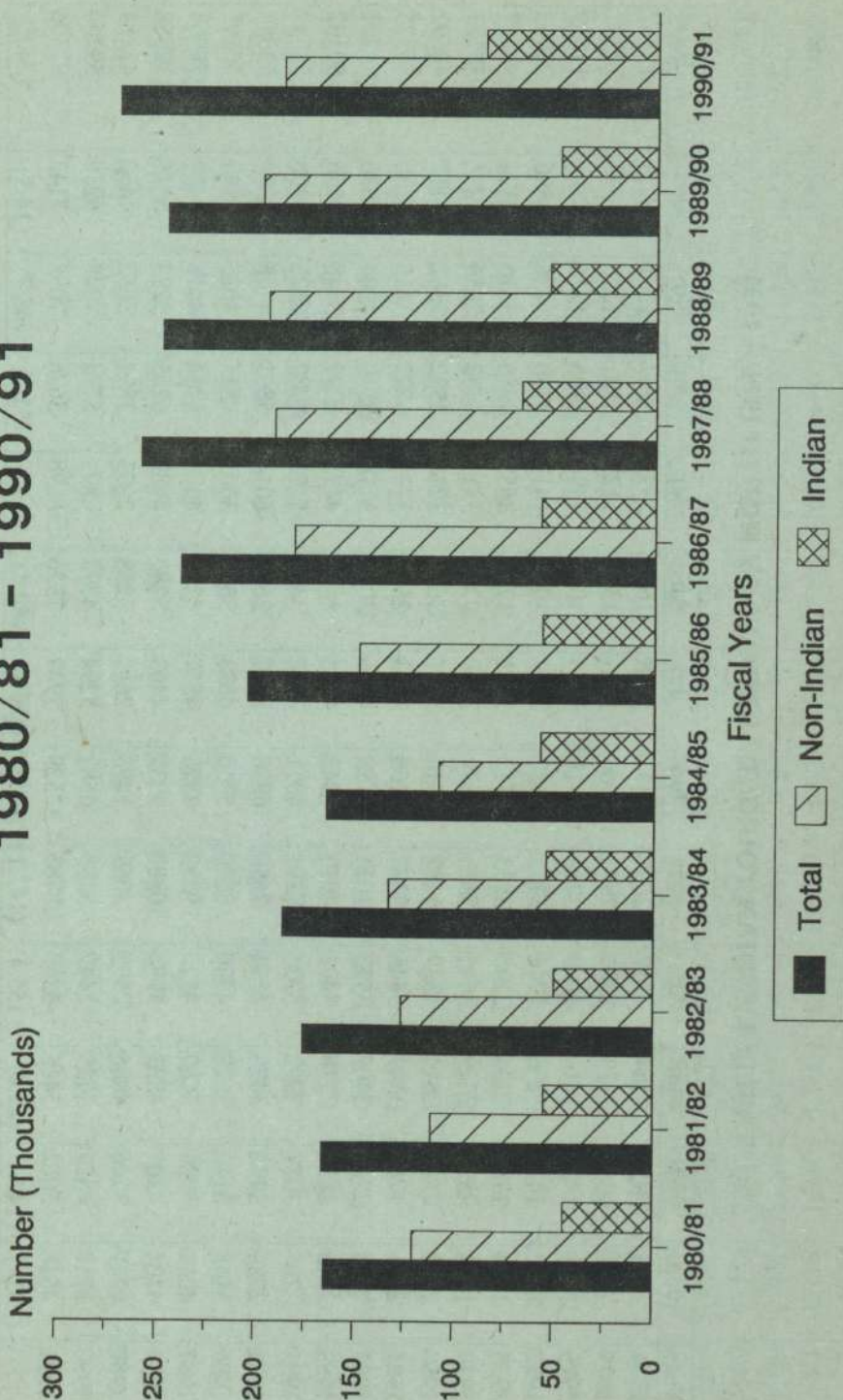

1962-1991

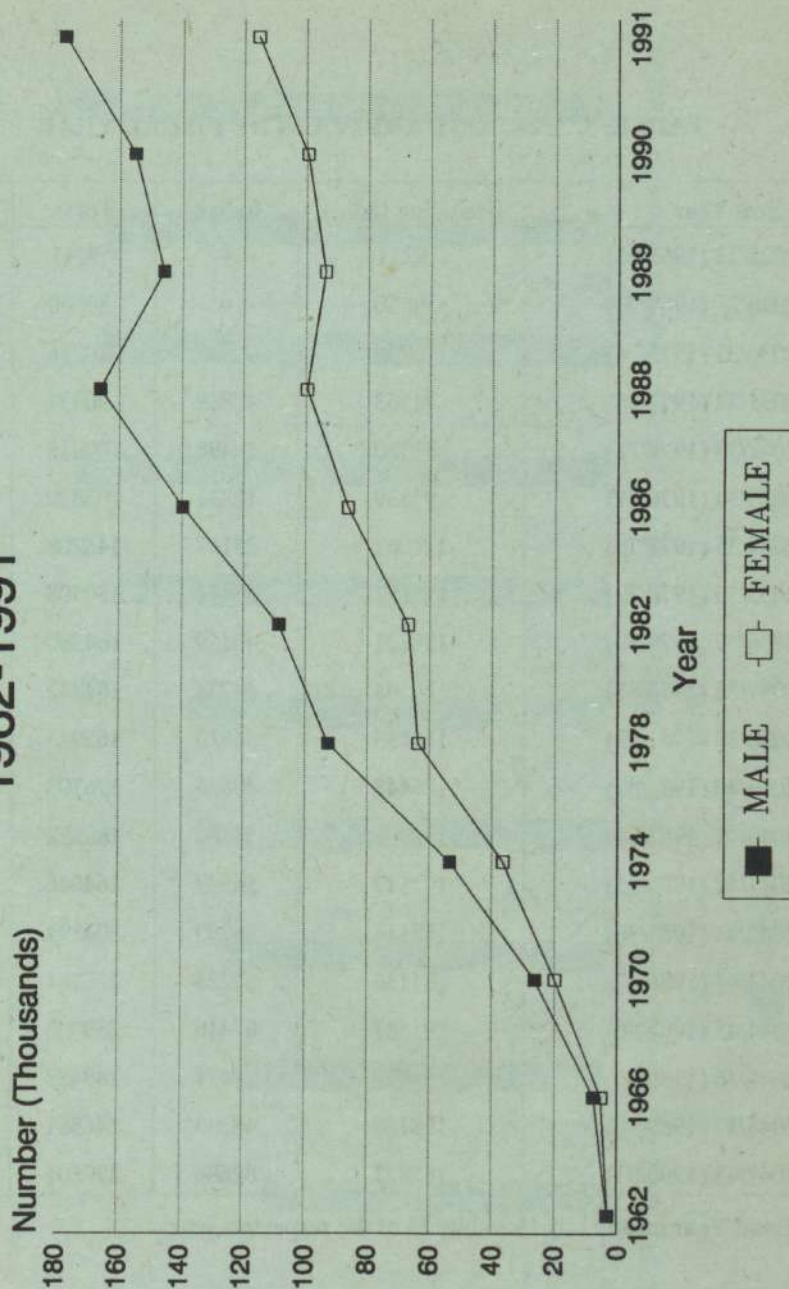


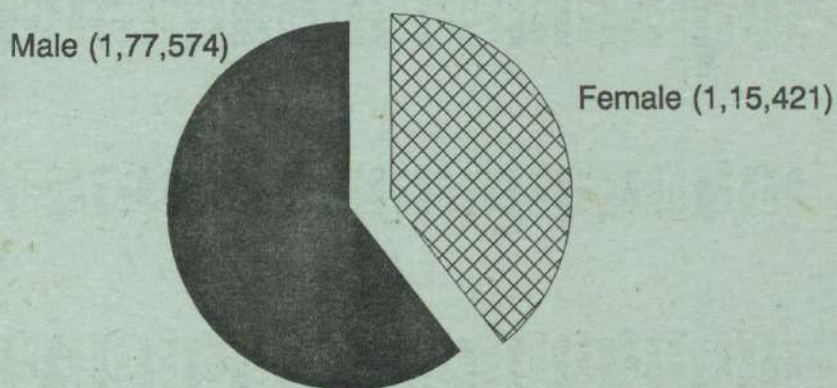

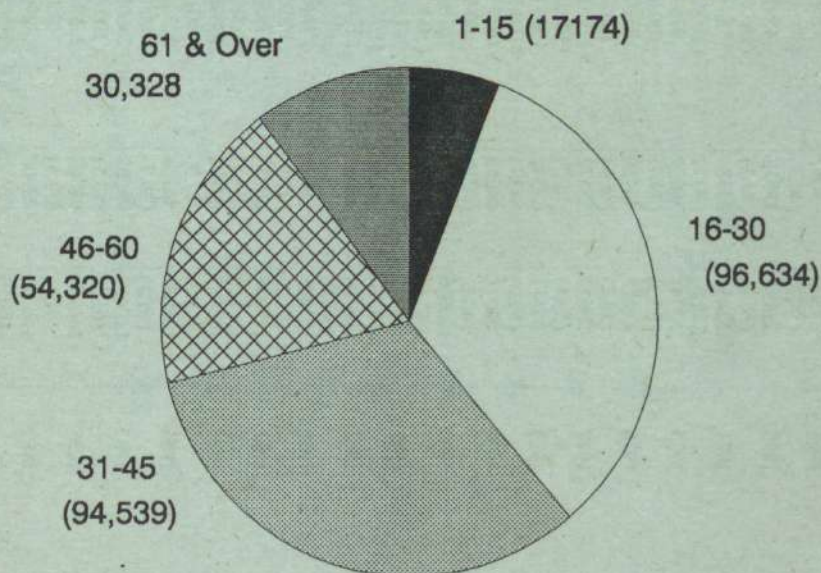
TOURIST ARRIVAL BY SEX

TOURIST ARRIVAL BY PURPOSE OF VISIT, 1991

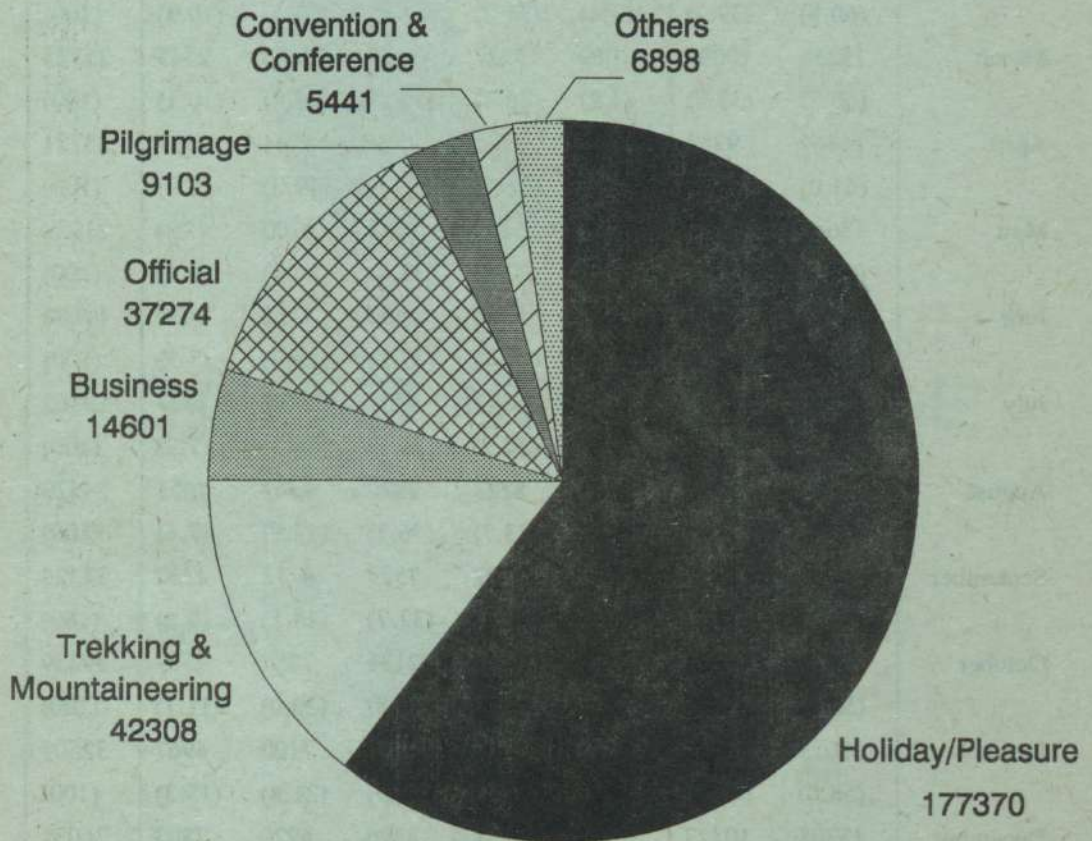

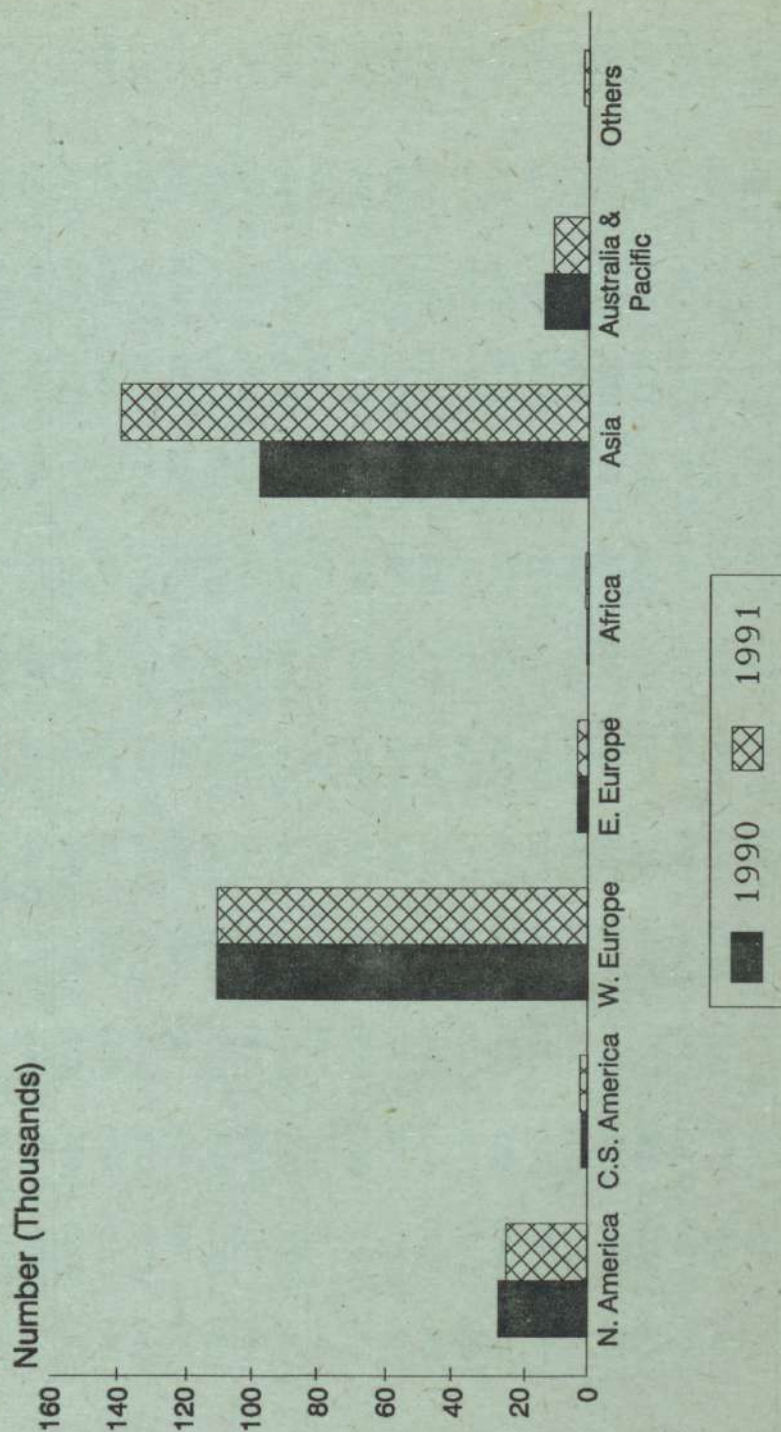

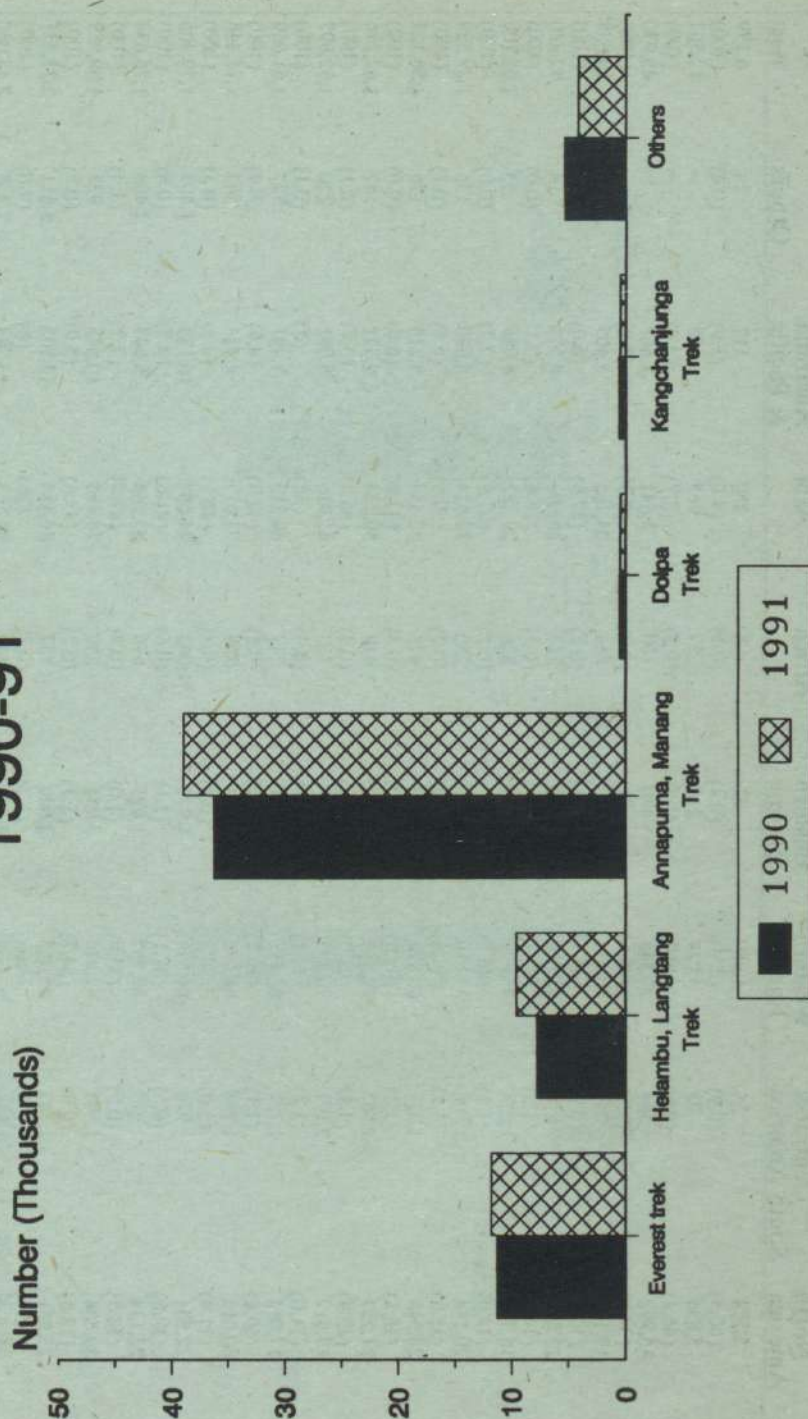

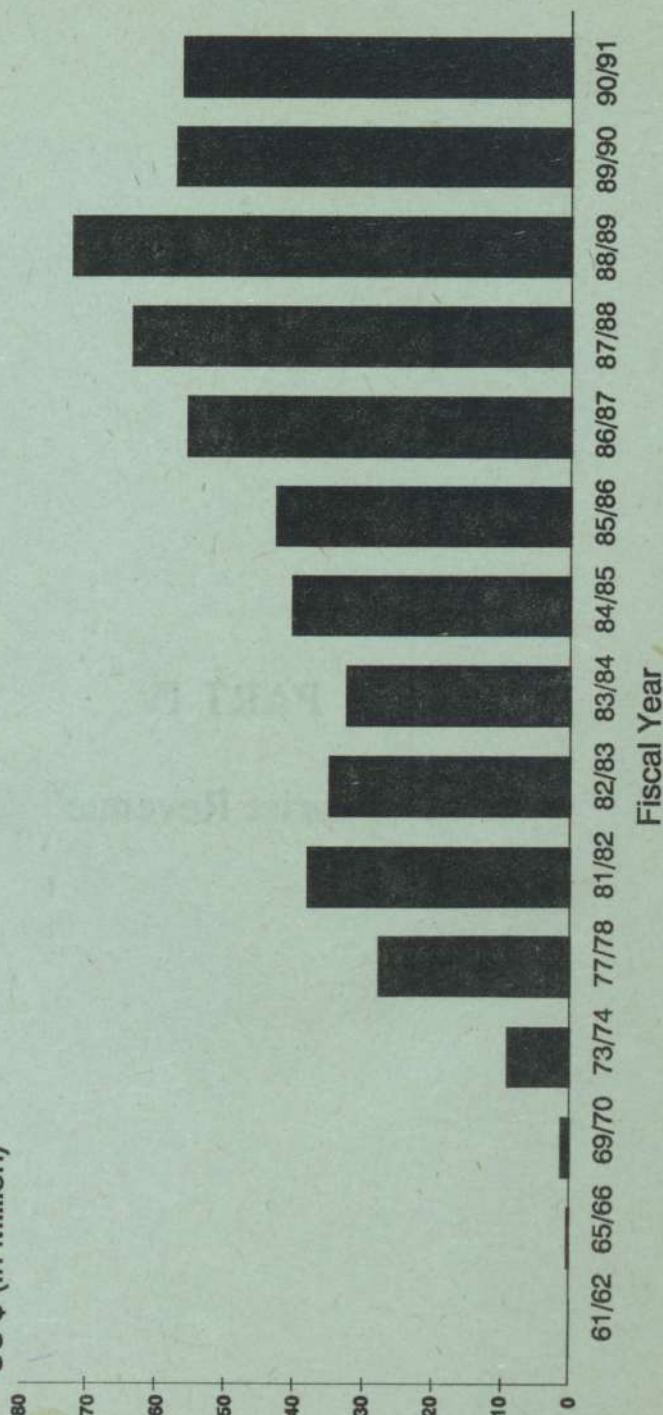

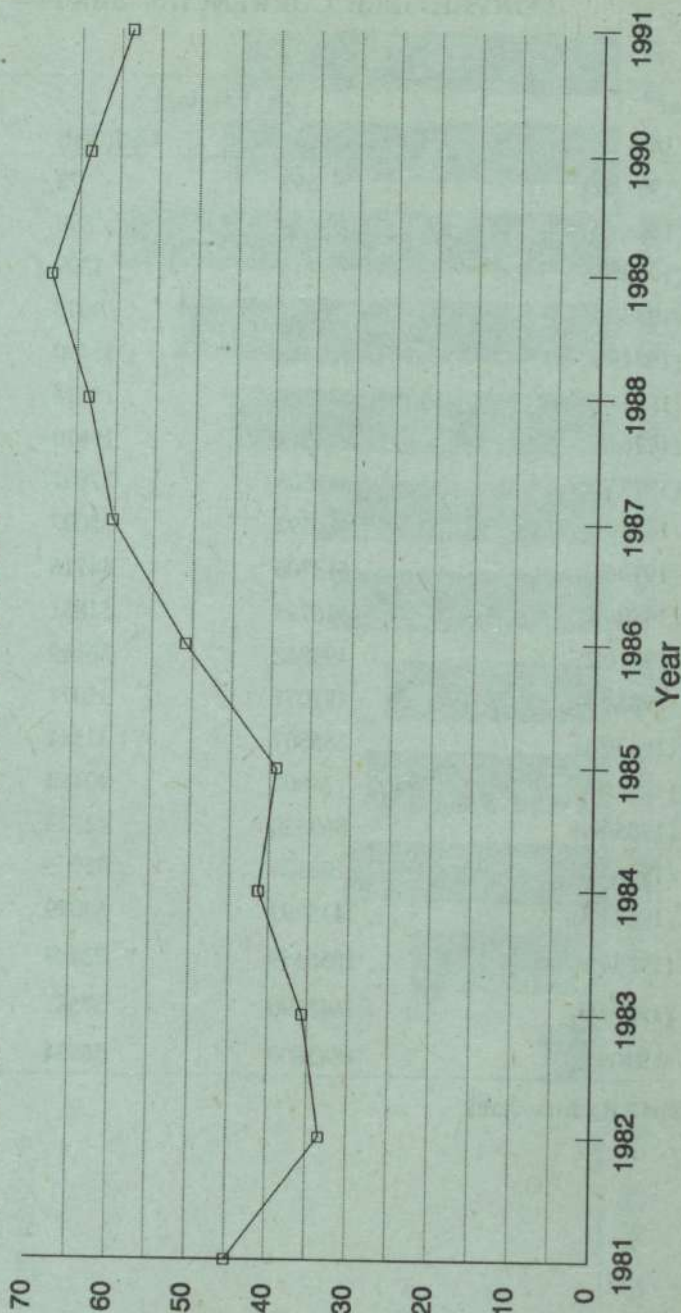

NEPALESE NATIONALS GOING ABROAD BY SEX 1991

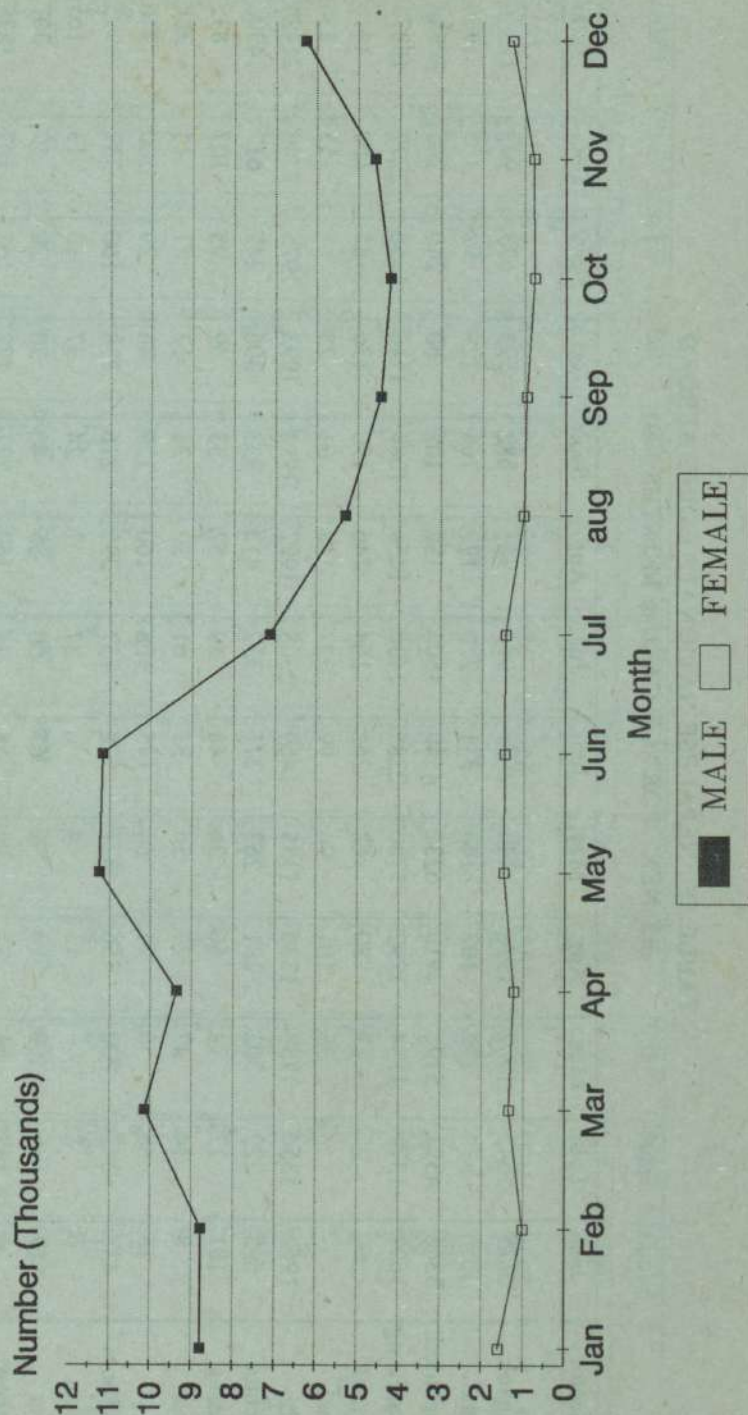
